Thursday, March 31, 1977

The Senate of the Ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 1977, convened at 11:30 o'clock a.m., with the President in the Chair.

The Divine Blessing was invoked by Reverend Satoru Hori of the Honpa Hongwanji, after which the Roll was called showing all Senators present, with the exception of Senator Nishimura who was excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Forty-Ninth Day.
