Tuesday, April 7, 1987

#### ORDER OF THE DAY

##### RE-REFERRAL OF RESOLUTIONS

The Chair re-referred S.C.R. No. 73, offered on Monday, April 6, 1987, jointly to the Committee on Tourism and Recreation and the Committee on Transportation.

The Chair also re-referred S.R. No. 80, offered on Monday, April 6, 1987, jointly to the Committee on Tourism and Recreation and the Committee on Transportation.



Senator Solomon's remarks on a point of personal privilege as follows:

"Madam Vice President, in 1985-1986 the University of Hawaii received \$69 million in extramural funding to support research, training, and students. Of this sum, organized research units generated more than half or \$36 million. If we use the income multiplier of two (2), which is a reasonable figure, the initial injection of \$69 million extramural funds will have a total economic impact of \$138 million and the \$36 million generated by research will have an impact of \$72 million.

"During this period the state invested \$17 million in appropriated funds to support the organized research units. This means for each \$1 expended by the state, the research units generated \$2 in extramural funds for a total of \$3 worth of research and \$6 in economic impact.

"In addition, there is an indirect impact generated when research programs have achieved national or international prominence. For example, the outstanding Institute for Astronomy generated over \$80 million in initial capital investments and in

1986, \$9 million in operating funds and had over 110 Hawaii-based people.

"The new Keck Observatory has an initial capital investment of \$85 million and in 1986 operating funds of \$2.3 million and have 35 Hawaii-based people. This telescope will become operational in 1991.

"All in all expenditure of funds for research is a good investment for Hawaii.

"At this time, Madam Vice President, I would like to, as the chairman of the Higher Education Committee, thank the Ways and Means chairman for restoring the \$8 million for the Mauna Kea access road and I would like to turn over the foregoing information to the chairman for his deliberations in the forthcoming conference.

"Thank you."
