

TWENTY-SECOND DAY

Friday, February 19, 1988

The Senate of the Fourteenth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 1988, convened at 11:37 o'clock a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Divine Blessing was invoked by Father Charles Kaleikoa of St. George of Waimanalo Catholic Church, after which the Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senator's Mizuguchi and Young who were excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Twenty-First Day.

The following introductions were then made to the members of the Senate:

Senator McMurdo rose on a point of personal privilege and said:

"Mr. President, this morning I gave testimony, not on behalf of the Senate but on behalf of my constituents, before the House Tourism Committee on the convention center and I would ask if I might submit those for incorporation in the Journal. Thank you."

(Senator McMurdo's remarks for insertion follows.)

"I speak in favor of H.B. 2973.

"The main logic for putting the convention center in the Kakaako peninsula is the vast economic advantage in developing our waterfront, and also the fact that the use of this area will not infringe upon any local residents. It could become an area that would benefit all of the people and not just our visitors. That way it would become a 'win-win' for everyone.

"This whole convention center movement is comparable to a giant juggernaut slowly moving forward to crush the dreams and hopes of thousands of residents and small businesspeople and destroying lifestyles they have chosen and followed for generations. Justifications for this

movement have been distorted and overly exaggerated to fill the apparent greed of one major hotel owner, and at the expense of thousands of our citizens in the communities of Waikiki, McCully, Moiliili, Kapahulu and Kaimuki.

"I feel certain that should a similar movement be underway which would so devastate the areas you represent, that you would fight to save your area and you would hope that your elected colleagues would use their wisdom to see beyond their own kuleanas.

"I ask you to take into account that all of the so-called organizations against the use of the Kakaako area are dominated by the one man to whom I earlier referred, and this includes the Hotel Association, Chamber of Commerce, Waikiki Improvement Association and, of course, his own lobbying organization, the Convention Park Council.

"Surely the Representative from Kakaako remembers when she represented the Moiliili area and the gallant fight they put up to save their residences and their businesses.

"And the Representative from Kaimuki cannot have forgotten so quickly the two recent town meetings where people in his district spoke out overwhelmingly against a convention center anywhere.

"Yesterday, when the merchants from the International Marketplace were having their quiet, polite demonstration here in the Capitol, I heard a lobbyist sneer from his position by the second floor railing, 'Who cares what they think? They aren't voters!'

"Is this really what the American dream is all about? Don't we care any more about all of our people? Or have we become elected representatives of only the rich and powerful? I hope that isn't the case, but sometimes I have to wonder.

"The Belt Collins Site Study is as follows:

I. RECOMMENDED SITE DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Overview

The development of a convention center on the Kaka'ako peninsula represents a unique opportunity for Honolulu, as well as the entire State of Hawaii. To date, deliberations over possible sites for a convention center have been largely focused upon the immediate impacts of the facility, the availability of a particular parcel of property, and the physical limitations of a potential site. While these are certainly worthy matters to be addressed and should not be ignored, their discussion has obscured a larger consideration. How does the convention center fit into Hawaii's plans for the future?

To be successful, in both functional and economic terms, a convention center must be a multi-purpose facility; not only in the sense of its usefulness for a variety of different gatherings, but also from the perspective of how it interacts with its surroundings and contributes to the community. We believe that a convention center can be much more than a grand meeting hall. It can become the cornerstone of our future. It can represent the foundation of a new industry, a new community, and a new direction for our economy.

The Kaka'ako peninsula convention center site plan expands on the many ideas and issues raised during the

recent Waterfront Redevelopment Plan Charette. The proposal represents a bold vision for the Honolulu waterfront, as well as the future of the entire State of Hawaii.

The site development plan looks beyond tourism as its major thrust, to a potentially new generation of economic activity. This plan looks to the future and accommodates the new roles that Hawaii could play in the new Pacific Age; as a place for regional and international businesses or governments to confer, a financial center to serve commerce and trade, a crossroads for cultural exchange, and a center for research and learning."
