AGREE OR DISAGREE

The Senate of the Fifteenth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 1989, convened at 11:43 o'clock a.m. with the Vice President in the Chair.

The Divine Blessing was invoked by the Reverend Taylor Potter, pastor of Mililani Presbyterian Church, after which the Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senator Cobb who was excused.
