Senator Matsuura then rose to speak on a point of personal privilege as follows:

"Mr. President, last week I mentioned about a newspaper article that was directed toward Senate Bill 2357. Now, this past Sunday there is an editorial, a large editorial, perhaps the largest editorial I've seen in the Hilo Tribune - Herald. I want to read the editorial into the Senate Journal because I'm not going to correct any of their incorrect statements. I hope that all the people of Hawaii will read the Senate Journal. Let me read it so you will understand what I'm trying to address in S.B. 2357. The article reads:

'Blatant attempt to cow isle press

'Barely a month ago, this country celebrated the bicentennial of the Bill of Rights. Already, the First Amendment to the Constitution has come under attack in Hawaii from a legislative bill introduced by Big Island State Sen. Richard Matsuura.

'Not that the First Amendment has never been challenged before over what, perhaps, are very valid issues. It has, and it's stood the test of time. But Matsuura's proposal reflects more of personal frivolity, or vendetta, than a philosophical or jurisprudential difference with the Bill of Rights.

'Under the guise of seeking corrections in the newspapers or the broadcast media, the bill actually would give politicians the right to dictate what to print in the papers or what to broadcast on radio and television. So far, only Deng Xiaoping, Fidel Castro and a few other dictators have such a right.

'If the bill becomes law, the newspapers, for example, would have to print a corrected statement from a politician without changes -- unless the changes are approved by the public official. The printing would have to be in the same place in the newspaper but in twice the space of the original statement. Inexplicably, the bill would apply to editorials and letters to the editor in which opinions are expressed. Under the protection of the First Amendment, Matsuura's bill would be unconstitutional.

'As the Honolulu-based media law attorney, Jeffrey Portnoy, succinctly summarized, the bill is an arrogant "attempt in legislative form to intimidate the media about writing a story about public officials." Undoubtedly it would have a chilling effect on stories about government affairs because any sources intimidated to recant statements could force the newspapers to print a correction.

'As the senator ought to know, it is the general practice of all mainstream newspapers in the United States to print corrections of factual errors. As a matter of policy, the Tribune-Herald publishes corrections of errors in fact that have been printed in the newspaper and will make the corrections as soon as possible after the error is brought to the attention of the editor. We have printed most corrections in a specific space on Page 2. Some have been printed in other pages, including the front page. This correction policy is working out well.

'Matsuura has explained that the bill was prompted by an incident in which he could not get a satisfactory correction printed in a Honolulu newspaper about a "totally false" story relating him to a land-use deal. (I don't know what he's talking about. I don't have a land-use deal.) But he also said he declined to accept an offer from the newspaper that he write a letter to the editor to explain his position because he did not want to appear to be complaining.

'Now he seems to have a change of heart and is making a big fuss through a legislative measure.

'It is not only unconstitutional in trying to tell the press what to print, it also is a repugnant, self-serving attempt to exert interference in the operation of a private business by requiring a newspaper to print the corrections in certain size and position. In short, it's a blatant attempt to cow the press in Hawaii.

'It would be a waste of precious time for the rest of the lawmakers to consider this frivolous measure. The quick way to deal with it is to chuck it.

'Matsuura would serve the interests of his constituents better by applying his talents to solving real problems such as housing, energy and financial aid to the counties than by attempting to rectify his personal problems by using his power as a legislator.'

'Mr. President, this bill has not been scheduled for a hearing yet. I told the Hawaii Tribune - Herald editor that for a bill to become law is very difficult. Very few bills actually make it to the end unamended. This bill, I'm sure, will be amended in the final form. The amendment could be that both parties would have to agree as to what is printed in the papers or the space may be the same. I don't know what amendments will be made.

'I want to clarify my position for the record. I'm not angry with the news media. I'm really not angry with the news media. They are some of my favorite people.

'I believe in the First Amendment! I'm totally for it! However, I don't like to be associated with Deng Xiaoping and Fidel Castro. I've never said that S.B. 2357 will apply to the letters to the editor. That is ridiculous! I'm not arrogant! I'm not the kind of person who intimidates. Believe me, I don't have a land-use deal! I don't have a land-use deal to correct! I don't have a change of heart. My stand is still the same. I'm not trying to rectify a personal problem and God knows I work hard and I try to do my best as a State Senator. Thank you very much."

Senator Koki also rose to speak on a point of personal privilege and stated:

'Mr. President, I have opposed using electronic voting machines during our election process. I have already cited numerous problems that I won't go into. To give a little background, I called several companies that produced voting equipment and materials to learn about the pros and cons of electronic voting machines. One of them was Sequoia Pacific. They sold us our present system and they also build and sell electronic voting machines. They were adamant that our present system was the best system for us. Our hardware needed upgrading if we wanted to get our results faster and that could be done for under \$500,000. Sequoia Pacific said they would love to sell us \$10 million worth of electronic voting machines but went on to list many reasons why we should simply upgrade our present system.

"Sequoia Pacific was not pursued to put in a bid to convert us to an electronic voting system. The Lt. Governor's office claimed Sequoia Pacific was biased because they supplied the ballots for our election and had an interest in not seeing an electronic voting system installed in Hawaii. Sequoia Pacific was not the only election firm to advise against an electronic system for Hawaii.

"Despite the multitude of reasons why an electronic system was not best for Hawaii, the Lt. Governor's office got approval from the Legislature to go ahead. Shouptronics was selected as the vendor. I checked on Shouptronics and informed the Senate and the Lt. Governor's office that Shouptronics was not substantial enough for us to commit ourselves for the next ten to twenty years. If they were to go out of business the integrity of our entire system would be in jeopardy. Despite this information, Shouptronics was the vendor the Lt. Governor worked with to convert our election system. Apparently, during the implementation stage, the Lt. Governor's office determined that Shouptronics was not qualified and sought another vendor. Sequoia Pacific was that vendor. The new RFP was designed in a way that Sequoia Pacific's electronic machine has the inside track. The very firm that insisted that the electronic voting machine was not for us.

"Shouptronics, obviously very disappointed, has charged that the new RFP contains flaws that contradicts FEC standards. I spoke to a Shouptronics official last week and he told me that the state is requiring information that could be used by the election administrator to alter the results of the election. I requested that he give me the details, in laymen's language, the portion of the RFP that contradicted FEC standards and how this then could be used to alter the results of the election.

"The official says that we are a unique state where the election observer and the administrator of the election are the same body. I am not accusing the Lt. Governor's office of any deliberate wrongdoing. But the way our electronic system is run, the potential of irregularity and fraud is apparent to all. We need to take steps to separate the observer and the administrator. Thank you."

The Chair then made the following observation:

"Members of the Senate, all senate bills have been printed, distributed to members, and were made available to the general public yesterday. Referrals, attached to today's order of the day, are complete. The last senate bill introduced was Senate Bill No. 3486."

Senator Blair then rose on a point of personal privilege and stated:

"On a point of personal privilege, Mr. President, I wish to extend, on behalf of all of the members, our thanks to your staff for their hard work in completing the referral sheets so quickly and the Print Shop staff for completing the printing so expeditiously. Thank you."

ADJOURNMENT

At 11:53 o'clock a.m., on motion by Senator Solomon, seconded by Senator George and carried, the Senate adjourned until 11:30 o'clock a.m., Wednesday, January 29, 1992.
