Tuesday, February 15, 1994

The Senate of the Seventeenth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 1994, convened at 11:06 o'clock a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Divine Blessing was invoked by Ms. Joy Turner, Minister, Director of International Ministries, after which the Roll was called showing all Senators present.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Seventeenth Day.
