Senator Solomon rose on a point of personal privilege and stated:

"Mr. President, I rise on a point of personal privilege.

"Mr. President, I would like to report to you as to where we're at with your Executive and Judicial Appointments Committee. What I have done for my colleagues' review is pass out a press release that was issued last night and a transcript of the first part of the hearing wherein the governor made his remarks and the committee responded. I felt that the committee was on track and that the governor's remarks were well taken, especially when he said and I quote from the transcript that is on your desk:

'The Senate is a separate branch of government. I know, I was once a Senator. And I respect the Senate's role in the process by which we serve our people, and certainly the Senate's role in the "advise and consent" is one that traditionally we have honored and respect that right.'

It goes on to say:

'I thank you for again reaching out and offering to put things behind us and to move forward. The State is facing a great fiscal crisis. The clouds that lie ahead coming out of Washington are indeed dark. I think that we all need to work together for the good of our state and our people, and I'm very, very happy that we have reached an understanding.'

"With that, Mr. President, I would like to thank my committee members. I think that in a trying time, they prevailed. And I'd like to report to you that we did pass out the six names. We asked the nominees tough questions, and all of them, I felt, did very well.

"Thank you."

The Chair then remarked:

"Thank you, Senator, for that report and I thank you and the members of the committee."

Senator McCartney then rose on a point of personal privilege and said:

"Mr. President, I rise on a point of personal privilege. In keeping with Aloha Friday, I would like to give a few brief remarks.

"I was at a community meeting last night in Laie, and the topic of discussion was what was going on in the Senate. And I reported what Senator Solomon, the chair of the committee, had done and there was applause and a great appreciation for her leadership. And I just wanted to express that in viewing that on television, it's a sign of moving ahead. It's a sign of her leadership and openness and a sign of recognizing that there's mutual respect and cooperation in doing the people's business. I'd like to commend her for that because I think it's a great day when people can have differences and move ahead. I think it's something that we can all be proud of on this Aloha Friday and I'd just like to thank Senator Solomon and commend her for that. "I'd also like to read a statement from a wise person. When I was a freshman, he gave this to me and to all of us here in the Senate. It talks about viewpoints and opinions, and it says:

'Different viewpoints and opinions are not wrong or bad or stupid. They are only different, and without such differences, viewpoints and opinions have no meaning. Viewpoints and opinions are creations of the mind and have validity only by agreement between persons. They are ultimate choices for different viewpoints and opinions which are changing constantly to cultivate different development of human beings. So appreciate and acknowledge those with different viewpoints and opinions.'

"I had the privilege of visiting a school in Houston, Texas, a few weeks ago with Senator Chumbley. It's one of the best schools in the country and we hope to bring it here under the title of Emerging Education. They have a credo that I'd like to read and I think it's very appropriate for Aloha Friday and it applies to everything that we do. (It's very short, Mr. President.) It says:

"Where there is love, there is concern. Where there is concern, there is kindness. Where there is kindness, there is harmony. Where there is harmony, there is helpfulness. Where there is helpfulness, there is cooperation. Where there is cooperation, there is civilization."

"Happy Aloha Friday, my colleagues and Mr. President."

Senator Graulty also rose on a point of personal privilege and stated:

"Mr. President, I rise on a point of personal privilege.

"Mr. President, I too would like to add my own thoughts and comments to the magnanimous actions by the chair of the Executive and Judicial Appointments Committee. We all have our pride, and particularly in the things that we do here which are often the stuff of which headlines are made. We expose ourselves and our families and friends to a great deal of public scrutiny, which makes it even more difficult to make an apology. I really take my hat off to the chairperson; it's not easy to make a public apology. And I think because she wanted the process to go forward and because she cared about the Senate as a body and as an institution, she was willing to set aside her personal pride and give the apology in order that we might be able to move forward. I think that was a remarkable and courageous thing that she did and I commend her for that and I thank her.

"Thank you, Mr. President."

Senator Holt rose on a point of personal privilege and said:

"Mr. President, I rise on a point of personal privilege on some of the sentiments made earlier.

"I was fortunate to be present last night on that historic occasion. I've served with the chairman for at least 12 years or so, and even my staff was ... I don't know what word to use ... they were just amazed! They said, 'That's not Senator Solomon. What happened to her?' And for the rest of the evening I did some soul searching and even had discussions with other Senators trying to figure out whether it was Senator Tanaka who massaged her or Senator Bunda who twisted her arm or even yourself, Mr. President. But I finally came to the conclusion that there's probably only one person that we handled

herself -- and that person is none other than her husband, Lima. (Laughter.) Thank you."
