The Senate of the Eighteenth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 1996, convened at 11:37 o'clock a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Divine Blessing was invoked by Miss Logan Hitchcock and Miss Jeanett Emley, Punahou School, after which the Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators Aki, Ihara and Ikeda who were excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Forty-Sixth Day.

Senators Taniguchi and Ikeda introduced Head Coach Vincent Goo and the University of Hawaii Wahine Basketball Team and its assistant coaches. Senate certificates and leis were then presented to the guests.

Senator Matsunaga introduced Nanci Kreidman, executive director of the Domestic Violence Clearinghouse and Legal Hotline. Senator Matsunaga then presented a lei to Ms. Kreidman and a check in the amount of \$400 on behalf of the Senate to the Domestic Violence Clearinghouse.

Senator Chumbley, with the assistance of Senator Levin, then introduced five recipients of the Milken Family Foundation National Educator Award. All of the guests were presented Senate congratulatory certificates and leis by various Senators.

At 12:00 o'clock noon, the Senate stood in recess subject to the call of the Chair.

Senator Kanno, chairman of the Committee on Agriculture, Labor and Employment, requested a waiver of the 72-hour Notice of a Public Hearing on S.C.R. No. 36 and S.R. No. 25, and the Chair granted the waiver.

Senator Grauly, chairman of the Committee on Judiciary, requested a waiver of the 48-hour Notice of a Public Hearing on S.C.R. No. 111, S.C.R. No. 285, S.R. No. 83 and S.R. No. 226, and the Chair granted the waiver.

Senator Solomon rose on a point of personal privilege as follows:

"Mr. President, an announcement, as well as a point of personal privilege.

"I had announced during the caucus, when we took up the Hawaiian sovereignty bill, that we would be meeting at the Kaumakapili Church this evening to bring the Hawaiian groups together to come up with a consensus. We have postponed the meeting and the reason for it is that the Office of Hawaiian Affairs, as well as, the Hawaiian Elections Council, feel they need time to consult with their members.

"The rally that you hear outside, I guess, is not in support of the Hawaiian vote. Rather than have them demonstrate at Kaumakapili Church, which I felt was inappropriate, I suggested that they come to the Capitol because this is where these kinds of activity should take place.

"So I just want to put you on notice that the different factions within the Hawaiian community, in fact, have not come to an agreement and we are hoping by April 25th, which is the deadline for the bills to go into conference, that we will have the opportunity to sit down and hammer out an agreement for all the groups to come together. I did communicate to them that the job of the legislature and the role of a legislator is to try to bring all special interest groups together. And as far as I am concerned, the Office of Hawaiian Affairs is a special interest group; Ka Lahui is a special interest group; and so are the other 200 Hawaiian organizations, or maybe there are 600 of them now that have registered as either a non-profit organization or other categories. They all represent their own perspectives. And I say again that the job of the legislature is to try to bring these groups together and see if, in fact, we can come up with a compromise solution so that they can start to move forward.

"I'm still hoping that organizations, including the Hawaiian trusts, such as the Bishop Estate, Queen Liliuokalani, Queen Emma Foundation, Lunalilo, can

participate. I've contacted all the Hawaiian trusts and asked them to participate because, if you will recall, when we first put this legislation together in 1991, the Hawaiian trusts were involved in the ideology and putting the concept together.

"So with that, Mr. President, I just would like to notify you and the rest of my colleagues, that we are still waiting for the Hawaiian groups to decide when they can come together for a meeting. We still intend to have our meeting at Kaunakapili to see if we can come up with a consensus.

"Thank you very much."

The Chair then remarked:

"The Chair thanks you, Senator Solomon, along with Senator Holt and Senator Aki for your leadership in this area."

Senator McCartney also rose on a point of personal privilege and stated:

"Mr. President, I would just like to echo that and thank the Senator from Kohala for her leadership. It's a tough issue and being on the Hawaiian Affairs Committee, being the vice chair, it's not an easy subject to deal with. Self determination is something that all of us in this state need to take a serious look at because it is going to be a subject of our times. And I was really pleased with the way the Senator from Kohala handled the situation, and the Ways and Means Committee brought the people to the table. I believe she said things that many of us couldn't have and she brought them together. And I commend you for that, for your courage and your leadership. Hopefully, at the end of conference something very good will come of it. So thank you very much."

Senator Holt added:

"Mr. President, I'd like to echo the comments made by the Senator from Kohala. She's done an excellent job in trying to bring this issue and resolve it amongst all the parties involved.

"On a point of personal privilege, Mr. President, anybody who knows football, knows that if you're coaching and trying to develop a system and you have a left-handed quarterback, you have to understand that that person writes left-handed, he eats left-handed, sleeps left-handed; he drinks left-handed, kicks left-handed, throws left-handed, and runs left-handed. And a person like Steve Young, when he wants to look good, and when I want to look good, I always roll to my left, not to my right. Thank you." (Laughter.)

Senator Holt, chairman of the Committee on Consumer Protection, then requested a waiver of the 72-hour Notice of a Public Hearing on S.C.R. No. 57, S.C.R. No. 149, S.R. No. 44 and S.R. No. 116, and the Chair granted the waiver.
