

NINETEENTH DAY

Wednesday, February 15, 2012

The Senate of the Twenty-Sixth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2012, convened at 11:42 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senator Kouchi who was excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Eighteenth Day.

At this time, Senator Shimabukuro introduced her friends Jessica Ear, a professor and lawyer for the Asia-Pacific Center for Security Studies in Honolulu; and Aldo Mauro, a restaurateur from Toronto, Canada.
