The Senate of the Twenty-Sixth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2012, convened at 11:36 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators English and Ihara who were excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Thirtieth Day.

At this time, Senator Baker, on behalf of Senators Tsutsui, English, and herself, introduced Kaili Mossman, a well-rounded and accomplished student at Kamehameha Schools Maui Campus.
