

## THIRTY-SEVENTH DAY

## Thursday, March 22, 2012

The Senate of the Twenty-Sixth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2012, convened at 11:33 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senator Ihara who was excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Thirty-Sixth Day.

At this time, Senator Nishihara recognized and congratulated Operation Manong (Office of Multicultural Student Services, UH Mānoa) on its 40th anniversary. Representing Operation Manong (OM) were its leaders Dr. Melinda Tria Kerkvliet, former director, 1986-1992; Dr. Ethel Ward, retired Farrington High School teacher; Dr. Amy Agbayani, former director, 1972-1986; Mr. Clem Bautista, OM alumnus and current director; and Mr. Jade Butay, OM alumnus.
