The Senate of the Twenty-Seventh Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2013, convened at 11:35 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators Dela Cruz, Shimabukuro, and Solomon who were excused.

The President announced that she had read and approved the Journal of the Nineteenth Day.

At this time, Senator Chun Oakland introduced a group of third- and fourth-grade students from Soto Academy and their teachers Rose Anne Nakamoto and Jan Wong. Senator Chun Oakland noted that among the students was Jase Arakaki, son of Doug Arakaki of the Senate Sergeant at Arms office.

Senator Kahele recognized and congratulated Daniel Ayala for being inducted into the National Senior Softball Hall of Fame. Mr. Ayala was accompanied by his wife Vivian, as well as other supportive teammates, friends, and 'ohana who were seated in the gallery.
