#### THIRTY-SEVENTH DAY

### Friday, March 22, 2013

The Senate of the Twenty-Seventh Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2013, convened at 11:17 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators Kahele and Thielen who were excused.

The President announced that she had read and approved the Journal of the Thirty-Sixth Day.

At this time, Senator Solomon, on behalf of the Hawai'i Island senators, introduced 23 eleventh-grade students from Honoka'a High and Intermediate School who were seated in the gallery with their teacher Mr. James Atkins.
