Senator Shimabukuro invited the members to an event the following day at 1:45 p.m. in Conference Room 224 to meet the Play Rugby USA team, comprised of professional athletes from

New Zealand, whose mission is to reach out to indigenous children and at-risk youth through rugby.

Senator Slom rose to speak on a point of personal privilege as follows:

"Thank you. I just wanted to, again, thank my colleagues for their generosity and their well-wishes. I was at a resort over the last week – the Kaiser Moanalua resort – and I had kind of a foot problem. But they had me tied down there, and I'm happy to confirm to my colleagues that they did do heart research, and I have a heart. And then they did look for my brain and they did find my brain and did an MRI, and despite some early diagnoses of Opening Day, there was no evidence of anything in my brain that was a thing. And my foot was kind of a problem because they had to take it from out of my mouth to work on it, but they did that.

"So I'm back here, but I do appreciate everything you did. I didn't want anybody to send flowers or cards or anything like that, and when I saw a wreath with a black band coming, I knew that was from the Senate.

"And thank you for designating Senator Nishihara to find out if I were dead. He came over, and we had a good debate for all of the staff over there on rail transit and taxation and things like that.

"You know, in the past 18 years, I had only missed one regular and special floor session in all that time, for a funeral for my then-father-in-law. So my streak is broken now; now I've gone three out of 19 years. But I hope to stay here and do that because I know that when I'm away, Madam President, that there seems to be an even greater rush to have the bad bills pass without any objection. And so I have to make sure that I'm back here to just give you a little bit of balance and a little bit of that.

"But the main thing is, I have said it before, I really enjoy being in the Senate. I enjoy all of you, and I appreciate all of your genuine support. Thank you very much."
