

TWENTY-SIXTH DAY

Thursday, March 12, 2015

The Senate of the Twenty-Eighth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2015, convened at 11:32 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present.

The President announced that she had read and approved the Journal of the Twenty-Fifth Day.

Senator Espero introduced his intern, Adrien Magpoc, a senior at American Renaissance Academy in Kapolei whose interests include politics and government and who will be attending San Francisco State University in the fall.

Senator Kahele welcomed Jesse Floyd, program specialist with the State Council on Developmental Disabilities, who was accompanied in the gallery by 31 residents from Hawai'i Island, including: from West Hawai'i – Jamison Akana, Danielle Dean Alford, Mary Ann Conner, Damian Steward Extor, Joshua Goetz, Lindsay Orred, Jeri Raymond, Shannon Salas, Robert Junior Sanoria, Jillian Leigh Sanoe Wong, and Quintin Wong; and from East Hawai'i – Nolan Alexander, Keoni K. Senator Chun Oakland introduced participants of the fifteenth annual State Council on Developmental Disabilities Day at the Capitol, held in partnership with Hilopa'a Family to Family Health Information Center and the Hawaii Waiver Providers Association. This year's event, with the theme "Don't DIS An ABILITY – Look At What We Can Do," drew over 500 individuals with developmental disabilities, family members, personal assistants, service providers, and friends from O'ahu and the neighbor islands, including 72 participants from Hawai'i Island, Kaua'i, and Maui. Senator Chun Oakland recognized Waynette Cabral of the State Council on Developmental Disabilities, noted how the event has grown over the years, and welcomed all participants who were in the gallery.

Senator Nishihara acknowledged the presence of Governor David Y. Ige in the gallery.

Senator Kouchi thanked Joni Shigematsu for bringing maile lei from Kaua'i, as well as two pre-Kindergarten groups from Wai'anae for visiting his office earlier that morning. Senator Kouchi then introduced "Senator" Sean Galuteria, son of Senator Brickwood Galuteria.

Senator Gabbard introduced his sister, Barbara Ann Gabbard, who had moved to Hawai'i from American Samoa 9 years ago and was enrolled in the Goodwill program in Kapolei.

Senator Shimabukuro noted that the State of Hawai'i and the Prefecture of Okinawa became sister-states in June 1985, and that the Hawai'i State Legislature passed H.C.R. No. 154 in 1990, requesting the Department of Education to establish an exchange program with Okinawa. Since the program's inception, over 700 Okinawa students and over 500 Hawai'i students have participated in the program, recognized as the longest running program of its kind. Senator Shimabukuro recognized the Hawaii United Okinawa Association and its 49 member organizations for their commitment, since 2011 to the present, to continue the program.

Senator Tokuda recognized the exchange program's twenty-fifth anniversary, noting that it had received acknowledgements

from the Hawai'i State Legislature, Mayor Kirk Caldwell and the Council of the City and County of Honolulu, and Governor David Y. Ige, the first governor of Okinawan ancestry. Senator Tokuda then introduced Okinawa Prefectural Board of Education officials Masahiro Unten, councilor; Tamotsu Miyagi, student exchange coordinator; and teachers Tadato Miyagawa, Chiaki Inamine, and Nina Shao; as well as Okinawa students Nanako Miyagi, Hibiki Shibata, Asuka Higa, Raita Seki, Momoe Oshiro, Momoko Miyamoto, Hiroka Itokazu, Shima Nakasone, Kotone Kamiya, Akari Arakaki, Sato Maehara, Shiho Hateruma, Erina Shimabukuro, Nao Tanahara, Seiya Ikehara, Koya Kakazu, Wakana Tokuyama, Sana Hamakawa, Iroha Mochida, Rihei Gushiken, Daisuke Kinjo, Hirono Tamashiro, Vanessa Anne Azurin, Suzu Nikawadori, and Anri Sekiya. Senator Tokuda also recognized local coordinators including Mark Higa, president of the Hawaii United Okinawa Association; Jane Serikaku, executive director and student exchange coordinator; Ron Miyashiro, *Hawaii Okinawa Today*; Charles Toguchi, former Superintendent of the State Department of Education; and Dennis Arakaki, former State Representative.

Senator Keith-Agaran, on behalf of Senate President Kim, recognized the Mediation Center of the Pacific, and presented the following remarks:

"Thank you, Madam President. On behalf of you, it's a pleasure to recognize one of the oldest community dispute resolution centers in the nation: the Mediation Center of the Pacific.

"The Center began modestly in 1979 as the Makiki Neighborhood Justice Center, its goal to resolve disputes among neighbors without hostility and protracted, costly legal proceedings.

"The Center changed its name to the Mediation Center of the Pacific, reflecting the broadening of its scope and caseload. Now headquartered in downtown Honolulu, the Center's offices are equipped with mediation rooms and communication technology to facilitate the mediation process. The dedicated staff and corps of volunteers train new volunteers and various constituencies to promote a broader understanding of the merits of alternative dispute resolution. More directly, they help to resolve conflicts in a variety of areas, often in partnership with the judicial system, public and private institutions, and other organizations.

"Throughout its distinguished history, the Mediation Center has remained true to its missions of serving groups and individuals across O'ahu, particularly the underserved; promoting a greater understanding and appreciation of alternative dispute resolution through education and training; continually improving its expertise; and generating funds to remain self-sufficient and support its volunteers. The Mediation Center of the Pacific is an invaluable contributor to the progress of our community and a key component of our legal and dispute resolution network. Its longevity stands as testament to the exemplary leadership of its staff and board, the talents and commitment of its volunteers, and the generosity of those who support the center's goals.

"Colleagues, please join me in commending everyone associated with the Mediation Center of the Pacific, past and present, on a remarkable record of service to the community. Representing the Center and joining us on the floor today are Mr. Gerald Clay, president; and Ms. Tracey Wiltgen, executive director.

"Joining us in the gallery are staff members from the center: Steve Holmberg, director; Ruth Tschumy, emeritus director; Jessica Stabile, deputy director; and Nathan Nikaido, mediator development manager. Also in the gallery are mediators who volunteer their services at the Center: Lisa Jacobs, Ellyn Tong, Phillip Nerny, and Sandra Jordan.

"And before I came down to the floor, Madam President, another former volunteer with the Mediation Center mentioned to me that he also has volunteered: Mr. Doug Chin.

"Now all of the members will see on their desks a copy of the Hawaii Mediation Pledge, and you're welcome to please sign the pledge and maybe use mediation if you have any particularly contentious hearings taking place."

Senator Ihara extended additional thanks to Gerald Clay for his mediation and facilitation services to the Senate.

The Chair acknowledged the presence of former State Senator Mike McCartney in the gallery.

Senator Kouchi acknowledged the presence of former State Senator Milton Holt in the gallery.

ADVISE AND CONSENT

Stand. Com. Rep. No. 903 (Gov. Msg. No. 513):

Senator Keith-Agaran moved that Stand. Com. Rep. No. 903 be received and placed on file, seconded by Senator Shimabukuro and carried.

Senator Keith-Agaran then moved that the Senate advise and consent to the nomination of DOUGLAS CHIN as Attorney General of the Department of the Attorney General, term to expire December 3, 2018, seconded by Senator Shimabukuro.

Senator Keith-Agaran rose to speak in support of the nominee as follows:

"The nominee, Mr. Doug Chin, brings to the state extensive and meaningful legal experience in both public service and private practice. Since 2013, he has served as managing partner at one of the largest and oldest law firms in Hawai'i, focusing his practice in the areas of corporate governance and transactions, administrative law, civil litigation, government affairs, and mediation. At his current firm, he has represented developers, businesses, and individuals in land use, real property, and civil litigation matters and testified before and advocated on behalf of clients to public officials, including the Legislature and county councils and various government boards and commissions.

"Previously, Mr. Chin spent 10 years with the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney for the City and County of Honolulu, including stints as first deputy prosecuting attorney and acting prosecutor. As first deputy prosecutor, Mr. Chin supervised a law enforcement agency with 250 employees in 6 divisions, including over a hundred attorneys, and a \$20 million budget. He also recruited and hired attorneys to serve as Honolulu prosecutors and coordinated training for all four county prosecuting attorney offices.

"In his criminal law career, Mr. Chin prosecuted over 40 jury trials, including murder and sex assault cases, while independently coordinating efforts between a team of police officers, investigators, detectives, victim advocates, and medical teams through all stages of a case from first charges to the final verdict. In 2002, Mr. Chin received the Honolulu prosecutors' internal 'Top Gun' award for winning the most jury trials that year.

"In between legal jobs, Mr. Chin also served as managing director of the City and County of Honolulu, where he was responsible for overseeing all 23 line agencies with approximately 10,000 employees and an operating budget of \$1.97 billion and a capital budget of over \$2 billion.

"Throughout his working life, Mr. Chin has been active volunteer in the community.

"Testimony in support of Mr. Chin's nomination confirmed that he possesses sound knowledge of the law, strong integrity, and deep understanding of government, administration, and law enforcement agencies. His work experience exemplifies his hard work and dedication to public service and his chosen profession. Throughout his working career, he has demonstrated the capacity to manage people and to grasp complex legal and challenging community issues. All of these traits and qualities will help him to serve as a successful attorney general. I am also confident that Mr. Chin understands the importance of providing consistent legal advice and counsel to the state's policy and decision makers in the different branches.

"Your committee found that Mr. Chin has the ability, character, and skills to serve as the attorney general of the State

of Hawai'i. And I like his heart. I urge my colleagues to confirm Doug Chin as Hawai'i's next attorney general."

"The Committee on Public Safety, Intergovernmental and Military Affairs held a public hearing on Thursday, March 5th, and has reviewed the personal history, résumé, and statement submitted by Nolan Espinda, and finds that he does possess the requisite qualifications to be nominated as the director of Public Safety.

"The committee finds that Mr. Espinda's background, experience, and commitment to public service qualify him for this important appointment. Mr. Espinda has extensive experience in the public sector, having worked for the Department of Public Safety for 32 years. Following his graduation from California State University with a Bachelor of Arts in political science, he began his career as a recreation specialist at the Hawaii Youth Correctional Facility in 1983 and later served as corrections supervisor, acting corrections manager, Office of the Institutions Division administrator, and managing ACO warden at the Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC). In 1994, Mr. Espinda received the Department of Public Safety's Manager of the Year award in recognition of his work. Since 2009, he has served as the managing ACO IV warden at Halawa Correctional Facility.

"We've had many discussions over the last few weeks. We know there are problems, but we also know that there are many hardworking professional members within our Department of Public Safety, and with Mr. Espinda's background and knowledge, I do believe that he is the individual. He is a straightforward, no-nonsense type of a man who can get the job done in this department of which, really, not too many people are clamoring to be the director. So with that, colleagues, I do ask you to support Stand. Com. Rep. No. 904 and Gov. Msg. No. 516, Mr. Nolan Espinda, for the director of Public Safety. Thank you."
