

THIRTY-SIXTH DAY

Friday, March 27, 2015

The Senate of the Twenty-Eighth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2015, convened at 11:34 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators English and Kouchi who were excused.

The President announced that she had read and approved the Journal of the Thirty-Fifth Day.

Senator Chun Oakland, on behalf of Senate President Kim and herself, introduced residents of the 'Ālewa Heights, Liliha, Pu'unui, and Nu'uānu area, who were accompanied in the gallery by State Representative Takashi Ohno and his staff and members of the Office of the Governor. Senator Taniguchi honored the Military Intelligence Service Veterans of World War II, and presented the following remarks:

"Thank you, Madam President. It is my pleasure this morning to welcome members of the Military Intelligence Service Veterans of World War II to the floor.

"Several thousand Hawai'i people, primarily Americans of Japanese ancestry, served with the U.S. Army's Military Intelligence Service, or MIS, in the war against Japan.

"These soldiers used their knowledge of the enemy's language and culture as interpreters, translators, prisoner-of-war interrogators, cave flushers, and spies behind enemy lines. Many engaged in actual combat. The MIS Nisei were credited with saving countless lives and shortening the war, but their service went largely unheralded because of the secrecy surrounding their work and the often-temporary, unrecorded diversity of their service. Their wartime service took them to such places as China, India, Burma, and to areas in the South Pacific.

"The MIS veterans, with their brothers of the 100th Infantry Battalion and the 442nd Regimental Combat Team, returned home to contribute to the development of the modern Hawai'i we now enjoy. These MIS veterans included such leaders as Governor George Ariyoshi; Hawai'i Supreme Court Justices Masaji Marumoto and Yoshimi Hayashi; Judges Frank Takao and Andrew Sato; attorneys Ted Tsukiyama and Francis Sogi; businessmen Ralph Yempuku and Kazuo Yamane; labor leader Koji Ariyoshi; educators Teichiro Hirata, Richard Kosaki, and my dad, Seiso Taniguchi; and many others who contributed to the betterment of Hawai'i.

"To mark the 70th anniversary of the conclusion of the war in the Pacific, the Military Intelligence Service Veterans Club of Hawaii is having a national reunion this weekend to honor the memory of their contributions and to celebrate the service of

these veterans who responded to our nation's call to duty. They will also mark the opening of an MIS exhibit at the Army Museum at Fort DeRussy. Please join me in giving them all a round of applause.

"On the floor today we have Mr. Robert Honke; he served in China, Burma, and India and was assigned to the 5th Radio Squadron to intercept and translate Japanese military communications. We also have Mr. Kenzo Kanemoto; he served in the Philippines, assigned as an interpreter for Japanese military war crimes trials there. We have Norman Hashisaka; he served in the occupation of Japan and as Far East Command interpreter at Japanese military war crimes trials there. We also have Andrew Sato; Judge Sato served in the mainland U.S. and Hawai'i, assigned as interpreter for Japanese prisoners in California. He also escorted Italian prisoners of war from Honouliuli back to Italy after the war. We also have another group of vets and their families in the gallery this morning."

At 11:41 a.m., the Senate stood in recess subject to the call of the Chair.
