

SECOND DAY

Thursday, January 21, 2016

The Senate of the Twenty-Eighth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2016, convened at 11:36 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators Ihara and Kahele who were excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the First Day.

At this time, Senator Dela Cruz welcomed 69 students from 6 different high schools and universities in Korea who were participating in a short-term exchange program with the University of Hawai'i – West O'ahu (UHWO). The exchange students were accompanied in the gallery by 16 students from UHWO; 6 staff members from both Korea and UHWO, including Tim Park of UHWO; and several chaperones.

Senator Kidani introduced the following students from Elsie H. Wilcox Elementary School's Student Council: President Kadee Parubrub, Vice President Ryan Chang, and Sergeant-at-Arms Keilee Salud. The students were accompanied in the gallery by teachers and advisors Christy Nii and Ronson Sahut. Senator Kidani noted that President Kadee Parubrub's participation in student government since the fourth grade inspired her to help others in less fortunate circumstances, which led to a "Random Acts of Kindness" movement that collected school backpacks, blankets for a senior home, more than 350 pounds of canned food, sports equipment, cleaning and school supplies, and many more items for several community charities.
