

## THIRD DAY

## Friday, January 22, 2016

The Senate of the Twenty-Eighth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2016, convened at 11:37 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators Green, Kahele, Keith-Agaran, and Tokuda who were excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Second Day.

At this time, Senator Baker recognized Hawaii Planned Parenthood, and presented the following remarks:

"Thank you, Mr. President. Mr. President and colleagues, on the day that Governor Ige proclaimed January 22nd as Planned Parenthood Day in Hawai'i, I'm pleased that the Senate will also recognize the 50 years of Planned Parenthood providing healthcare services to women and men here at home. Just like its counterpart across the country, Planned Parenthood, a century-old organization nationally, is rooted in the courage and tenacity of American women and men willing to fight for women's health, women's rights, and equality. The hallmark of Planned Parenthood's mission is to provide contraception and other health services to women –and men; fund research on birth control; and educate specialists and the public about the results of that research; and ultimately, to advance access to family planning here in Hawai'i, in the United States, and around the world.

"January 22nd is also an auspicious day for women's health rights, as it is the date, back in 1973, that the United States Supreme Court handed down the landmark decision for women, *Roe v. Wade*. That decision helped to empower women by giving them control over their healthcare decisions. Oddly enough, *Roe v. Wade* wasn't decided on women's right to bodily autonomy but on the basic, fundamental right to privacy in making healthcare decisions, those medical decisions. Justice Harry Blackmun wrote, 'This right to privacy is broad enough to encompass a woman's decision whether or not to terminate her pregnancy.' Women were able to move from the dark, dank back alleys and coat hanger abortions to safe, sterile, bona fide medical facilities.

"Here in Hawai'i, we always strive to provide access to as many healthcare options as possible for all people. And Planned Parenthood Hawaii has been doing just that for 50 years.

"Planned Parenthood Hawaii, known now as Planned Parenthood of the Great Northwest and the Hawaiian Islands, is a nonprofit organization providing medical services, education, cancer screening, pregnancy counseling and testing, testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections, comprehensive sex education, preventive healthcare services, birth control for both men and women, emergency contraception, and, yes, abortion services.

"Planned Parenthood here in Hawai'i has provided access to the fundamental human right of access to healthcare by promoting the ability of individuals to lead fulfilled lives; building healthy families; and making informed decisions through high-quality health services, education, and advocacy.

"Mr. President, it's my pleasure to yield the floor to Senator Thielen, who will introduce our honorees on the floor."

Senator Thielen rose to present the following remarks:

"Thank you, Mr. President. It's my honor today to introduce the healthcare professionals and healthcare support staff from

Planned Parenthood Hawaii; if you would please stand when I call your name. Joining us today are Dr. Reni Soon, the Hawai'i medical director; Cindy Muir, the Honolulu Health Center manager; Laurie Field, Hawai'i legislative director and public affairs manager; Sonia Blackiston, Hawai'i educational program manager; Sheila O'Keefe, Hawai'i development officer; and Dylan Simosko, the training manager. If we could acknowledge our floor guests today.

"Thank you. In the gallery, we also have a number of representatives and supporters. If they could please rise, and I would like to turn the microphone back to Senator Roz Baker to acknowledge them personally."

Senator Baker continued:

"Yes, we have a number of supporters of Planned Parenthood in the gallery, some of them wearing red, some of them wearing the hot pink circles. We want to thank you all for your support, but I also want to call out Andrea Anderson and ask her to rise. Andrea is a former executive director of Planned Parenthood in Hawai'i, I've had the pleasure of working with her on a number of issues over the years. So, Andrea and all the supporters of Planned Parenthood in the audience, if you'd please rise to be recognized."

Senator Inouye introduced Ruslan Babayev, a student from Ukraine attending Parker School as a participant in the Future Leaders Exchange (FLEX) Program.

Senator Taniguchi introduced Houssam Aljawhari, a student from Lebanon attending President Theodore Roosevelt High School as a participant in the Kennedy-Lugar Youth Exchange & Study (YES) Program.

Senator Thielen welcomed the fifth-grade class of Le Jardin Academy, who was present in the gallery with teachers Maggie Foley, Suzie Gamble, and Kathy Thomas.

Senator Dela Cruz extended additional acknowledgement to Amber Nobriga, student body president at Le Jardin Academy.

Senator Dela Cruz then introduced Daniela Mendelevic, a student from Lithuania attending St. Andrew's Priory School as a participant in the Exchanges for Culture, Education, and Leadership (ExCEL) Program.

Senator Galuteria introduced Madjiguene Babou, a student from Senegal attending St. Andrew's Priory School as a participant in the YES Program.

Senator Espero, on behalf of Senate President Kouchi, introduced Khanoum Gevorgian, a student from Armenia attending Waimea High School as a participant in the FLEX Program; and Eris Fani, a student from Albania attending Island School as participant in the YES Program.

Kenichiro, Ryukyu Mura theme park assistant general manager. The guests were accompanied by Chisako Oshiro, their translator; Jane Serikaku, executive director of the Hawaii United Okinawa Association; and Senator Wakai's wife, Miki Wakai, from the Hawai'i Tourism Authority.

Senator Slom extended an additional welcome to the exchange students and visitors from Okinawa, and acknowledged his own Okinawan staff member, Kathryn Higa, who was present in the Senate Chamber.

Senator Slom then recognized members of the Leike family, who were present in the gallery: Louise Leike, a successful businesswoman in Atlanta, Georgia; Jessica Leike, a successful leader in Houston, Texas; and Jeric Kalani Leike, director of the Boys & Girls Club of Hawaii Charles C. Spalding Clubhouse and recipient of the Maytag Dependable Leader Award.

At 11:56 a.m., the Senate stood in recess subject to the call of the Chair.
