And I think, over the years, we've tried to narrow those purposes and, particularly, when we're talking about charitable donations. It's one thing to be charitable – that means you reach in your own pocket and give your own money. It's another thing to reach in somebody else's pocket or to accept their money when they thought that you were running for election or had a contested race. So, I think, in order to be consistent, we should make sure that we keep campaign funds for campaign purposes. Thank you."
