

SECOND DAY

Thursday, January 19, 2017

The Senate of the Twenty-Ninth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2017, convened at 11:37 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senator Galuteria who was excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the First Day.

At this time, Senator Kidani commended and congratulated Cherise Imai for outstanding service to the State of Hawai'i and Hawai'i's military families, and presented the following remarks:

"Mr. President and colleagues, some of us had the opportunity to participate in last week's programs, when the Chamber of Commerce Hawaii laid out issues of concerns regarding our State's military bases and our neighbors and their families who are stationed here. The presentations organized by the Chamber's Military Affairs Council underscored not only the tremendous importance of the military in Hawai'i but also reaffirmed our commitment to fully engage this largely transient population. We learn and benefit from the diversity these men and women and their families bring to our islands. We encourage opportunities to share our island culture, values, and the aloha spirit, and we appreciate their contributions to the economic vitality of our communities.

"One of the most important venues through which military families participate in our neighborhoods is the public school system. Some 14,000 military dependents enrolled in schools on O'ahu, Kaua'i, and Hawai'i Island represent about 8 percent of the 180,000 students in the current school year. The Department of Education has long recognized how important it is to integrate these children and young men and women into our schools. With the help of the late Senator Dan Inouye, the DOE established the Joint Venture Education Forum in 1999 to coordinate policies and practices. Our former colleague in the other chamber, Representative Mark Takai, was instrumental in putting together resources for the Hawai'i DOE team who works with the military on those efforts.

"I offer this background and context so that we can appreciate the outstanding contributions to this important work that our guest this morning was involved in with the DOE for about a decade until late last year. May I please introduce Cherise Imai? During her time at the DOE, Cherise actively engaged in numerous programs and projects that benefited our military students, such as Federal Impact Aid, the Military Interstate Children's Compact Commission, National Association of Federally Impacted Schools, Military Impacted Schools Association, Military Youth Advisory Council, and countless state-, district-, and school-level efforts. Her guidance and support of various federally funded grant applications helped the DOE receive more than \$25 million to provide resources at the state, district, and school levels. The beneficiaries of this funding are our students, always a priority for Cherise. Now Cherise, alas, is no longer with the DOE. Late last year, she accepted an opportunity to apply her expertise and talents to a national position as executive director of the Military Interstate Children's Compact Commission in Lexington, Kentucky. Our loss is certainly their gain. Because we were not in session at this time when Cherise moved to the mainland, we did not have an opportunity to accord her the recognition for her work in Hawai'i that she so richly deserves. I am pleased to present a certificate of congratulations and gratitude on behalf of the Senate and our colleagues in the

House for outstanding service to our public schools, our friends and families in the military, and the State of Hawai'i. Mahalo, Cherise.

"Mr. President, with Cherise on the floor this morning are Brigadier General (retired) Kathleen Berg, who is a state Hawai'i commissioner to the Interstate Children's Commission and Senior Assistant Superintendent and Chief Financial Officer of the Hawai'i DOE Amy Kunz. Thank you for being here.

"Mr. President, Cherise has family members and others in the gallery this morning we would like to recognize: her sisters Chris Agena and Kammie Aguada and two-month-old niece J.C. Also, Rick Masters, legal counsel for the Council of State Governments, who flew to Hawai'i to be here with Cherise for tomorrow's meetings of the Hawai'i Interstate Compact Council. They will be meeting here in the Capitol at 10 a.m. tomorrow. And we should also acknowledge Cherry Okahara, who succeeded Cherise as a Hawai'i DOE military liaison. Thank you and mahalo to all school liaisons and military and community stakeholders who do such good work on behalf of our schools and communities. I would also like to acknowledge Sami Takai, who's present today, and all of you know – as we talked about her late husband, Mark, who was so special for us in this endeavor – so thank you for being here with us today. Thank you, Mr. President."
