At this time, Senator Inouye rose to inform the members that she would be attending the Women's March at the State Capitol the following day at 10:00 a.m.

Senator Espero rose to speak on a point of personal privilege as follows:

"Today marked the final day of a fruitful eight years of leadership from one of Hawai'i's native sons, President Barack Obama. His mark on America and the world will undoubtedly go down in history as one of the most successful and most significant Presidents to have ever been elected to office. I, for one – and I think I can speak on behalf of our entire state – will miss him dearly. To our new President, good luck.

"Over his two terms, the President has accomplished more things than I could have hoped for. I want to highlight just a few of his major accomplishments under his tenure.

"Under President Obama's leadership, we went from a horrible recession in 2008 to a stock market at record highs, unemployment at record lows, and job creation in the millions. President Obama's bailout of the U.S. auto industry in 2009 saved three million jobs.

"In 2010, the President passed a landmark healthcare bill known as the Affordable Care Act, ensuring that millions upon millions of Americans can get the health care they need, effectively sending a clear message that whether you are poor or wealthy, you are equally deserving of quality health care in America.

"As the mortgage and banking crisis took hold, President Obama, working with Congress, passed critical oversight laws like the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform Act that improved regulations of eight key areas of the financial sector that went unchecked for too long and led to the financial crisis we all knew too well.

"In 2010, President Obama and Congress agreed on \$858 billion in tax cuts. These tax cuts included a \$56 billion

extension of unemployment benefits for those who were still suffering from the effects of the Great Recession. Businesses received \$140 billion in tax cuts for capital improvements. The estate tax, commonly utilized by some of the wealthiest in our society, was exempted up to \$5 million.

"President Obama promised to fight terrorism, and under his command, Osama bin Laden, America's Public Enemy No. 1, was eliminated.

"As a staunch defender of the environment, President Obama finalized the International Climate Agreement in Paris, where countries agreed to reduce carbon emissions and increase carbon trading. In 2015, he also enacted the Clean Power Plan, which would reduce CO₂ emissions by 32 percent from 2005 levels by 2032.

"For our brothers and sisters in the LGBT community, President Obama repealed the military's 'Don't ask, don't tell' policy that for so long had cast a cloud on the exemplary service of those military men and women who defend our country and our rights yet had to live their lives in secret, as second-class citizens. President Obama also directed that the federal government would no longer provide a legal defense for the Defense of Marriage Act, which effectively led to the U.S. Supreme Court decision legalizing same-sex marriage across the country.

"Colleagues, I could go on and on about the wonderful accomplishments our native son and his team have done for our nation. It is my firm belief that the history books will soon write Obama's name alongside the likes of Lincoln, Roosevelt, and Kennedy.

"With the peaceful transition of power from his administration to the next, I am energized and committed to doing my part in defending the progress President Barack Obama has made and to fight even harder where we need to.

"He said, 'Yes, we can,' and I know, yes, we will.

"I have no better, more poignant way to end this but by saying, 'Thank you, Mr. President.' Thank you, Mr. President."
