

TWENTY-THIRD DAY

Thursday, March 2, 2017

The Senate of the Twenty-Ninth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2017, convened at 11:33 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators Dela Cruz and Rhoads who were excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Twenty-Second Day.

At this time, Senator Kidani introduced North Carolina State Senator Dan Blue, president of the National Conference of State Legislatures (NCSL), who was seated in the Senate Chamber, and acknowledged his educational and professional background, as well as some of his legislative and community involvement and accomplishments. Senator Kidani also recognized Senator Blue's wife, Edna Blue, who was not present. Senator Kidani then introduced Bill Pound, executive director of NCSL, and Corina Eckl, director of leader services, who were seated in the gallery.

Senator Tokuda welcomed a group of sixth-grade students from Trinity Christian School, who were present in the gallery with their teacher, Eric Fugitt, and praised them for being active in the legislative process by writing letters to her about issues they care about and bills they are tracking.

Senator Shimabukuro recognized Demont and Momi Conner, constituents from Nānākuli who were seated in the gallery, and noted their diligence in advocating for O'ahu's Westside.

Senator Galuteria commended and congratulated John Yukio Gotanda on becoming president of Hawai'i Pacific University, and presented the following remarks:

"I see the chamber is flush with presidents today, and I'd like to add one more to the roster. Take this time, colleagues, to acknowledge Mr. John Yukio Gotanda, who became the fifth president of the Hawai'i Pacific University. HPU is the largest private university in the State of Hawai'i, and he was inducted on July 1, 2016. Born and raised in Hawai'i, President Gotanda is a graduate of Roosevelt High School, the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa, and the William S. Richardson School of Law, where he was editor-in-chief of the University of Hawai'i Law Review. Following law school, he was a staff attorney with the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit. He then worked as an associate attorney with Covington & Burling in Washington, D.C., and later with Goodwin, Procter & Hoar in Boston.

"In 1994, he joined the faculty at Villanova University, where he served as professor of law, associate dean for academic affairs, associate dean for faculty research, and director of the JD/MBA program. From 2011 to 2016, he served as a dean of the law school of Villanova. Under his leadership, the Villanova law school developed and implemented a strategic plan that radically reformed the school's curriculum, reducing the time and cost of the program, eliminating barriers to entry, and establishing and increased international opportunities for its students.

"President Gotanda is recognized as one of the world's leading authorities on damages in international law and has been cited by courts, tribunals, and commentators, including by the U.S. Supreme Court. He has spoken widely on the subject of damages, international arbitration, and international sales law, including the Hague Academy of International Law, and has served as an expert on damages and an arbitrator in

international investment disputes. Under President Gotanda's leadership, HPU will build on its successes to date as it continues to prepare graduates to live, work, and learn as active members of a global society and realize its vision to become a leading institution of higher education.

"Including in that, colleagues and President, our new president of HPU is a fellow musician and a keyboard player. And back in the day, when there was a limited list of keyboarders, he was playing all over the place in Waikīkī. Colleagues, for those of us who used to run around Waikīkī in the day, you remember the Point After? Remember Cilly's? Remember even the Top of Da Shoppe? Well, President Gotanda played at all of those places. So, we've got some sentimentality in that way.

"Joining him today is his wife, Brenda, and his mom, Masae. Thank you very much. Mr. President."

The Chair commented:

"We'll make the correction in the Journal: Senator Galuteria, I believe you said, 'For those of you who ran around Waikīkī in the day,' it would appear the word was 'at night,' late night."

At 11:41 a.m., the Senate stood in recess subject to the call of the Chair.

The Senate reconvened at 11:49 a.m.
