

## FIFTEENTH DAY

Friday, February 9, 2018

The Senate of the Twenty-Ninth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2018, convened at 11:38 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Fourteenth Day.

At this time, Senator Shimabukuro recognized Demont Conner and Rachel Kailianu, constituents from her district who actively participate in the legislative process.

Senator Chang introduced Lory Peroff, a fourth-grade teacher at Waikīkī Elementary School, *Honolulu Civil Beat* columnist, and Hope Street Group Teacher Fellow.

The Chair extended an additional welcome to Lory Peroff, and noted that he had read her most recent column.

Senator Nishihara introduced Lorna Baniaga-Lee, a ninth-grade English teacher at James Campbell High School and Hope Street Group Teacher Fellow.

Senator Kidani noted that the Hope Street Group Teacher Fellows Program had enrolled more than 60 Hawai'i teachers since its founding in 2014 to enhance leadership skills and expand professional learning networks, and introduced additional Hope Street Group Teacher Fellows: Aurene Padilla, a Central District resource teacher; Whitney Aragaki, a math and science teacher at Waiākea High School; Caroline Freudig, a Kaua'i Complex Area resource teacher; Stephanie Mew, a third-grade teacher at Kapunahala Elementary School; Erin Mendelson, a special education teacher at several O'ahu elementary and middle schools; Cecilia Chun, an instructional coach at Ka'imiloa Elementary School; and Julie Reyes Oda, a math teacher at Nānākuli High and Intermediate School.

Senator Kahele, on behalf of Senate President Kouchi, recognized and congratulated Kalani Vierra and Krystl Apeles, and presented the following remarks:

"Colleagues, aloha kakahiaka kākou. As someone who carries the name Kaiali'i and whose family has a special connection to the ocean, there are two special guests in the chamber I would like to introduce. This morning, the Senate is honored to recognize and congratulate Mr. Kalani Vierra and Ms. Krystl Apeles for winning the 2017 International Tandem Surfing Association Championship on August 24 and 25, 2017, at Kūhiō Beach here in Waikīkī. Mr. Vierra and Ms. Apeles bested the top 12 tandem surfing teams from over 7 different countries to capture the 2017 tandem surfing championship title with a total score of 12.42 points in the championship round. Joining them in the gallery is their gymnastics coach, Mr. Jack Leonard; as well as Ms. Dana Kalmey, who has devoted the past two years to developing a documentary on Mr. Vierra and Ms. Apeles's tandem surfing journey. We would also like to recognize the friends and family members who have come to support them: Mr. Daniel Erickson, Ms. Apeles's boyfriend; and Ms. Jennie Tamashiro, Ms. Apeles's godmother. Mahalo."
