

## SEVENTEENTH DAY

## Tuesday, February 12, 2019

The Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2019, convened at 11:32 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Sixteenth Day.

On behalf of Senate President Kouchi, Senator Taniguchi recognized and congratulated Illinois State Senator Toi Hutchinson and William T. Pound, and presented the following remarks:

"Today, we have guests from the National Conference of State Legislatures joining us. The NCSL was founded in 1975 to increase the quality and effectiveness of state legislatures, improve interstate communication, and advocate for states at the federal level. On the floor this morning, we are honored to have Illinois State Senator Toi Hutchinson, the newly elected president of NCSL. Senator Hutchinson has been a long-time champion of women's and children's rights, and a strong supporter of the minimum-wage increase in Illinois. Next to her is Mr. William T. Pound, a founding member and the longest serving executive director of NCSL. Bill is a visionary whose leadership transformed NCSL into the standard in American politics for bipartisan cooperation among state legislatures. Joining us in the gallery this morning are two additional people from NCSL: Ms. Martha Saenz and Ms. Irene Kawanabe."
