

## EIGHTEENTH DAY

## Wednesday, February 13, 2019

The Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2019, convened at 11:33 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Seventeenth Day.

At this time, Senator Dela Cruz recognized Audrey Case, wife of United States Representative Ed Case.

Senator Baker commended and congratulated the 2018 Hawai'i Healthcare Heroes, and presented the following remarks:

"Colleagues, the Healthcare Association of Hawaii is a leading voice for healthcare providers in our state. The organization works to positively influence state and federal policy to provide quality and accessible health care to the people of Hawai'i. Before we get to the introductions of the folks on the floor, I'd like to recognize a couple of folks in our gallery: The head of the Healthcare Association of Hawaii, Hilton Raethel, and he's also joined by some of the other staff and members, so if all of those individuals could stand to be recognized, please?"

"Colleagues, through HAH Healthcare Heroes awards, patients are given the opportunity to acknowledge the service of outstanding healthcare providers, those who have demonstrated exceptional commitment and noteworthy expertise. These providers are honored for their exemplary care they deliver to patients and their loved ones across Hawai'i. They truly are the epitome of selfless service for the betterment of our community and, therefore, are more than worthy to be honored as a 2018 Healthcare Hero. I'd like to now yield the floor to Senator Rhoads for our first introduction."

Senator Rhoads rose to present the following remarks:

"Our first Healthcare Hero is Dr. Christie Izutsu of O'ahu, who was nominated for this award by the family of the late Richard Kaneshiro. During Richard's medical journey, Dr. Izutsu was truly thoughtful and steadfast by being just one call away at all times. Working as a nephrologist at the Kidney Clinic of Hawaii, Dr. Izutsu demonstrates top-notch professionalism and compassionate care. She is dedicated to her profession, ensuring every single one of her patients receives unparalleled care. She uses a patient-centered team approach while also striving to make the tumultuous cancer journey as stress-free as possible. Her unwavering care for her patients, seen with her efforts as a listening ear and a guiding voice, makes her deserving of the award as a Healthcare Hero. Could we please give a round of applause to Dr. Izutsu? I would now like to yield the floor to Senator English. Mahalo."

Senator English rose to present the following remarks:

"Our next Healthcare Hero is nurse Valerie Janikowski from Lāna'i. One of Valerie's patients, Walter Hanog, says that if it weren't for Valerie, he may have lost his legs. But Valerie was not discouraged by Walter's complex medical scenario; as a home healthcare nurse, she cleaned and dressed his wounds, gave insulin shots, monitored his intravenous treatments, and organized his medication intake. She also arranged for off-island medical checkups, including air and ground transportation. It was comprehensive, compassionate caregiving. Now, with Valerie's dedicated care, Uncle Wally still has both of his legs and is able to walk again despite being told by several doctors that they would need to be amputated.

Valerie truly is a Healthcare Hero. I'd like to say mahalo, thank you very much, Valerie, and, from experience in the islands, kommol tata. I'd like to now yield the floor to Senator Kanuha."

Senator Kanuha rose to present the following remarks:

"Our next Healthcare Hero is nurse Dee Ono from Hawai'i island, who has helped many of my family in Kona; mahalo for all that you've done in the community. Caring for people in their homes creates a special kind of patient-caregiver bond, and these relationships can naturally evolve into friendships. Through her kind and generous spirit, Dee inspires hope in patients who feel like there is none. One patient in particular is Clayton Punihaole: Through Dee's compassion and authenticity, she helped Clayton realize that dialysis was not a death sentence but just another chapter in life's story. Dee reassured Clayton that his family and medical team truly cared about him and that, in their trusted hands, things could be different. Dee supported Clayton at dialysis and podiatry checkups, and provided in-home care. Dee Ono's care and tireless support allowed Clayton to enjoy life again and advocate for those disabilities and, for this reason, is being honored as a 2018 Healthcare Hero. Please give a round of applause for my aunty, my good friend, Dee Ono. I will now yield the floor to the senator from Hawai'i Kai."

Senator Chang rose to present the following remarks:

"Our next Healthcare Hero today is Dr. Rebecca Sawai of O'ahu. Dr. Sawai is a general surgeon specializing in colon and rectal surgery at Kaiser Permanente Hawaii. She chose medicine because it allows her to combine her interest in science with her fondness for working with people. Her patient Jeffrey Peterson witnessed her outstanding professionalism and empathy. He is especially thankful for Dr. Sawai's ability to be proactive by creating a plan of attack to extend his life. She took the time to communicate the medical terms to Jeffrey as well as the strategy they'd be following. Dr. Sawai knows that it is important to be able to communicate procedures clearly to patients as a form of full engagement from both healthcare provider and patient. Because of Dr. Sawai, Jeffrey didn't miss out on milestones in the lives of his children, and it is through wonderful stories such as this that we are proud to recognize Dr. Rebecca Sawai as one of our 2018 Healthcare Heroes. How about a round of applause? I now yield the floor to Senator Kim."

Senator Kim rose to present the following remarks:

"Mr. President, I'm in such awe to witness and see all of these heroes sitting on our floor here in the chamber, and so our final Healthcare Hero is nurse Lesley Yoshimori of O'ahu. Lesley Yoshimori demonstrated her selflessness and dedication to her profession when her patient at Tripler Army Medical Center, Sheldon Kimura, was diagnosed with amyloidosis that required a heart transplant. When Sheldon's treatment was moved to Stanford, Lesley did not stop helping her patient, and she remained proactive as a resource and an advocate. Lesley became instrumental in pushing through Sheldon's medical needs, from coordinating discussions between Tripler and Stanford to being someone the patient and the family confided in at a time when decision-making was growing tougher. Professionals like Lesley embody the power of altruistic actions in times of hardship, making her truly noteworthy for the award as a 2018 Healthcare Hero. May we have applause for our hero Lesley Yoshimori? And now I yield the floor to Senator Baker."

Senator Baker then rose to offer wholehearted thanks and to say "mahalo nui loa" to all of the honorees for the significant and positive force that they are in their chosen fields.
