

## THIRTY-SIXTH DAY

Thursday, March 21, 2019

The Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2019, convened at 11:34 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators Kahele and Keohokalole who were excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Thirty-Fifth Day.

At this time, Senator Kidani rose and stated:

"A student's success relies not only on the efforts of educators in the classroom but extends to administrators as well. We acknowledge today's honorees for the personal and educational support they provide to students as the students navigate the challenges of their academic careers. Introducing the 2018 Counselor of the Year and 2019 national finalist Counselor of the Year is the senator from Wai'anae."

Senator Shimabukuro recognized Desiré DeSoto of Wai'anae High School, and presented the following remarks:

"Desiré DeSoto has always been a competitor. This beautiful and talented Mākaha native successfully competed for several years as a professional longboard surfer. She was so good at her craft that she was asked to portray the young Rell Sunn in the movie *Heart of the Sea*. She's brought that same competitive spirit and talent to the children of Wai'anae since joining the high school staff there in 1996; for the past 12 years, she has been serving as a school counselor. 'The most rewarding part of my work,' she says, 'is bearing witness to the growth, development, and maturation of my students. There are no words to describe the feeling of witnessing students overcome obstacles and fulfill their post-high school goals and dreams.' And those students are better equipped to overcome those obstacles because of the love, dedication, and skill of a true competitor who teaches and guides them how to be competitors in life. In the gallery to support Desiré, we have photographer and another West Side awesome surfer, wahine, Pākē Salmon. Mahalo for being here. And could you stand, Desiré, to be recognized and honored? Mahalo! I'd now like to yield the floor to the senator from Puna."

Senator Ruderman honored Sara Kamibayashi for receiving the 2018 Librarian of the Year Award, and presented the following remarks:

"Colleagues, it's my pleasure to introduce Sara Kamibayashi. Sara is the branch manager of Naalehu and Pahala Public Libraries, and, in this capacity, she's continuously demonstrated an outstanding level of dedication and commitment to the Big Island community and to the values of the Hawaii State Public Library System. Originally from Virginia, Sara came to Hawai'i to volunteer at Volcanoes National Park, where she met her husband. In 2008, she earned her master's degree in library and information science from Florida State University and bachelor's in archeology from Oberlin College. After serving as a substitute librarian at Hilo Public Library, she became a full-time librarian in 2013. Colleagues and library patrons have shared that Sara's always warm and welcoming and willing to try new programs to ensure that her small branches are well-used and full of excitement. Congratulations to Sara, and thank you for all that you do. I'd like to turn the floor over to the senator from North Hilo."

On behalf of Senator Kahele, Senator Inouye honored Mona Tavares for receiving the Friends of the Library of Hawai'i

2018 Excellence in Service Award, and presented the following remarks:

"The Friends of the Library of Hawai'i was founded over 150 years ago and, through its ever-expanding community involvement, has seen public servants of the highest caliber this state has to offer. On behalf of Senator Kai Kahele, who represents the 1st District in Hilo, in his absence, I'm happy to recognize Mona Tavares, who is one such remarkable individual who seeks to cultivate a society that informs and develops the minds of future generations. In her 27 years of service, she has worked tirelessly to help bring the Hilo Public Library into the twenty-first century.
