

## TWENTY-NINTH DAY

Tuesday, March 10, 2020

The Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2020, convened at 11:36 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators Fevella, Harimoto, and Kahele who were excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Twenty-Eighth Day.

At this time, Senator English recognized the Kamehameha Schools Kapālama boys and girls wrestling teams, and presented the following remarks:

"Members, I'm very pleased today to introduce students and coaches from Kamehameha Schools, my alma mater, in Kapālama in upper Kalihi. These are the two-time winners of the Texaco/Hawaii High Schools Athletic Association wrestling state championships, which were held last month at the Blaisdell Arena. The two-time state overall champions for both boys and girls won under the skillful instruction and mentoring of the always-motivating head coach, Rob Hesia. Coach Rob, a 2004 graduate of Pacific University in Oregon, was named the 2019 coach of the year by the Hawaii Wrestling Coaches Association at the national body's meeting, which was held in Pittsburgh last year. This two-time winning coach and his group of assistant coaches and support staff are also in our gallery: Fallyn Kapoi, Dave Chew, Shayden Terukina, Jonathan 'Kai' Kamaka, Shana Dilliner, Chris West, Jonah Hoshino, Keli Ross, and Richie Cabinian; wrestling team mothers Michele Nash, Keao Kaaialii, and Cory Porter; and team manager Keahe Ross. Let's give them all a big hand, please. I'd like to now yield the floor to my colleague from Kapālama."

Senator Kim rose to present the following remarks:

"I'm honored to introduce the boys and girls championship teams. Not only is Kamehameha part of my district (you know, 'ring, ring, Kalihi, ring'), but also my son's alma mater: He was a lifer at Kamehameha. So, in the boys wrestling championships, Kamehameha boys scored 207.5 points and took home their championship title for the second year. On the floor, we have Kysen Terukina (four-time state champion), Brant Porter (his second state crown), and Kana'i Tapia and Manaia Wolfgramm (a first state win for both of them). In the gallery: Kahékili Pahio, Jonah Chew, Scotty Dikilato, Josiah Hokoana, Jonah Kahuli-Apo, Kaimalu Kahalioumi-Vinluan, Chaz Kuikahi-Molina, Akoni Kaaialii, Dustin Dano, and Andrew-Lee Smith. Congratulations to the men of Kapālama!"

"And for the second year in a row, the girls hold the title of 2020 Texaco/HHSAA wrestling champions, and they finished with 169 points to secure the girls' title. On the floor, we have first-place champs in their weight division Paige Respicio and Haley Narahara. In the gallery, we have Krystal Puahala, Skye Realin, Nohea Moniz, Aliya Takano, Laamea Harbottle, Amy Sotoa, Mehana Kapoi, and Kylee Bartholomew-Tangaro. Congratulations to the women of Kapālama!"

The Chair announced that since there was a short agenda, the Senate would adjourn then meet and congratulate its honored guests. The Chair also noted that head coach Rob Hesia, a 2004 Pacific University graduate, had been a roommate of Kaua'i County Council Chair Arryl Kaneshiro.
