

THIRTY-SECOND DAY

Friday, March 13, 2020

The Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2020, convened at 11:55 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senators Harimoto, Kahele, and Nishihara who were excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Thirty-First Day.

At this time, the Chair recognized Patrick Wu, a Punahou School graduate who had been a roommate and coworker of his son Dan when they both worked for United States Senator Mazie Hirono, and who currently works with the United States Department of the Treasury in Washington, D.C.
