Thursday, June 25, 2020

The Senate of the Thirtieth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2020, convened at 11:32 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present, with Senators Chang, Ruderman, and Thielen present and participating via videoconference, and with the exception of Senators Ihara and Wakai who were excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Forty-Fourth Day.

STANDING COMMITTEE REPORTS

Senator Nishihara, for the Committee on Public Safety, Intergovernmental, and Military Affairs, presented a report (Stand. Com. Rep. No. 3666) recommending that H.B. No. 1794, H.D. 2 pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

On motion by Senator Kahele, seconded by Senator Fevella and carried, the report of the Committee was adopted and H.B. No. 1794, H.D. 2, entitled: "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO DISASTER RELIEF," passed Second Reading and was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Senator Wakai, for the Committee on Energy, Economic Development, and Tourism, presented a report (Stand. Com. Rep. No. 3667) recommending that H.B. No. 1820, H.D. 1, as amended in S.D. 1, pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

On motion by Senator Kahele, seconded by Senator Fevella and carried, the report of the Committee was adopted and H.B. No. 1820, H.D. 1, S.D. 1, entitled: "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY," passed Second Reading and was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Senator Wakai, for the Committee on Energy, Economic Development, and Tourism, presented a report (Stand. Com. Rep. No. 3668) recommending that H.B. No. 1912, H.D. 1, as amended in S.D. 1, pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

On motion by Senator Kahele, seconded by Senator Fevella and carried, the report of the Committee was adopted and H.B. No. 1912, H.D. 1, S.D. 1, entitled: "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE PACIFIC INTERNATIONAL SPACE CENTER FOR EXPLORATION SYSTEMS," passed Second Reading and was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Senator Wakai, for the Committee on Energy, Economic Development, and Tourism, presented a report (Stand. Com. Rep. No. 3669) recommending that H.B. No. 2366, as amended in S.D. 1, pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means and the Committee on Judiciary.

On motion by Senator Kahele, seconded by Senator Fevella and carried, the report of the Committee was adopted and H.B. No. 2366, S.D. 1, entitled: "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS TAX," passed Second Reading and was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means and the Committee on Judiciary.

Senators Thielen, Wakai, and Inouye, for the Committee on Government Operations and the Committee on Energy, Economic Development, and Tourism and the Committee on Transportation, presented a joint report (Stand. Com. Rep. No. 3670) recommending that H.B. No. 2699, H.D. 2, as amended in S.D. 1, pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

On motion by Senator Kahele, seconded by Senator Fevella and carried, the joint report of the Committees was adopted and H.B. No. 2699, H.D. 2, S.D. 1, entitled: "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT," passed Second Reading and was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

At this time, Senator Shimabukuro announced that the Committee on Hawaiian Affairs would be holding a public hearing on a number of Senate resolutions that afternoon at 12:30 p.m. in Conference Room 016.

The Chair then made the following announcement:

"The deadline to file standing committee reports on House bills that need to pass Second Reading and move laterally to the final Senate committee is 6:00 p.m. this evening."
