The Senate of the Thirty-First Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2021, convened at 11:42 a.m. with the Vice President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present, with Senators Chang, English, Gabbard, Ihara, Keith-Agaran, Keohokalole, Lee, Misalucha, Rhoads, Riviere, and Shimabukuro present and participating via videoconference, and with the exception of Senator Kouchi who was excused.

The Vice President announced that she had read and approved the Journal of the Nineteenth Day.

At this time, Senator Rhoads acknowledged Eileen Nims, his legislative attorney who had delivered a Moment of Contemplation prior to the Senate's floor session, and introduced other staff members, who were seated in the gallery: intern Frankki Ramirez, intern Camille Dahmen, legislative aide Lynell Yuu, and committee clerk Elena Arinaga.

"At this point, the emergency management chapter, chapter 127A, only allows for misdemeanor offenses no matter what the crime, whatever the action taken that was not appropriate. This bill will allow for the governor and the mayors, in emergency orders during emergency situations, to designate what they view as lesser crimes and attach lesser penalties to them. They can take, for example, the mask-wearing violation, and they could designate that as an infraction, and it will be treated almost identically to a traffic ticket. So I think it's important we move this forward. The court system was inundated with misdemeanor charges over the last year, and it's not a good way to enforce what are generally viewed as important in the sense of, you don't want COVID to spread, but do we really want to put somebody in jail for a year because they didn't wear their mask? I urge my colleagues to move this forward. Mahalo."
