

## TWENTY-SEVENTH DAY

## Thursday, March 11, 2021

The Senate of the Thirty-First Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2021, convened at 11:36 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present, with Senators Chang, Gabbard, Keohokalole, Lee, Rhoads, Riviere, and Shimabukuro present and participating via videoconference, and with the exception of Senator Ihara who was excused.

Ultimately, consideration on balancing how to provide relief to our working families and not run afoul of federal restrictions will be determined on guidance the U.S. Treasury provides on the American Rescue Plan Act, which has yet to be published. At this point in time, the guidance we are receiving is that if legislation would result in a decrease in tax revenues, then there needs to be legislation, a tax package, that would offset the decrease as to not run afoul of the restrictions included in the American Rescue Plan Act. If we pass and enact legislation that results in a net tax decrease, the state will forego the equivalent amount of federal aid from the state fiscal relief fund in the law. Our staff is in contact with and is contacting our congressional delegation, Leader Schumer’s office, and the U.S. Treasury for guidance. To avoid jeopardizing Hawai‘i’s share of the American Rescue Plan Act, these bills may be deferred at a later time. Thank you.”

It killed nearly 20,000 people, and 2,500 people are still missing. Today, thousands of people have not returned to their homes in the area

for various reasons, including high radiation. Through this moment of silence, I hope we can convey our deepest condolences to all those affected by this tragic event. Thank you.”

Senator Keohokalole spoke on a point of personal privilege as follows:

“Today also marks the one-year anniversary of the World Health Organization designation of COVID-19 as a pandemic, and I’d also like to request a moment of silence on behalf of the more than 2.6 million individuals globally who’ve lost their lives, including more than 500,000 Americans. Thank you.”
