The Senate of the Thirty-First Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2022, convened at 11:34 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present, with Senators Acasio, Chang, Dela Cruz, Gabbard, Keohokalole, Lee, Moriwaki, Rhoads, Shimabukuro, and Wakai present and participating via videoconference.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Twenty-Second Day.

At this time, Senator San Buenaventura introduced members of her staff who were seated in the gallery: office manager Linda Menda; committee clerk Jackie Rosas; legislative assistant Amelia Castro; and University of Hawai'i Hilo intern Billie-Ann Bruce, who had offered a moment of contemplation prior to the Senate's floor session. Senator San Buenaventura commented that she was proud to have sponsored Ms. Bruce as her UH Hilo intern, continuing the tradition of Senators Kahele. Senator San Buenaventura then acknowledged remote staffer Baron Sekiya, legislative assistant.

By unanimous consent, action on Stand. Com. Rep. No. 2723 and S.B. No. 2755, S.D. 1, entitled: "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE BOARD OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES," was deferred until Thursday, March 3, 2022.
