SECTION 1. House Concurrent Resolution No. 32, is amended by amending page 2, lines 31 to 34, to read as follows:

"BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State of Hawaii and cities in Hawaii are encouraged to continue to work for peace and international goodwill and understanding through their existing sister state and sister city relationships with any Russian, Belarusian, and Ukrainian provinces or cities; and"

Senator Taniguchi moved that Floor Amendment No. 3 be adopted, seconded by Senator Ihara.

Senator Taniguchi rose to speak in support of the amendment as follows:

"Floor Amendment 3 addresses sister-state and sister-city relations in House Concurrent Resolution 32. The sixth 'Be it resolved' in the resolution calls for cutting off any existing relations with Russian or Belarusian provinces or cities. Currently, the State of Hawai'i does not have any sister-state relations in Russia, but we believe the City and County of Honolulu has a sister-city relation with a city in Russia.

"International sister-state relations are not completely government-to-government activities. They are meant to be individual-elected-official-to-elected-official relations and ultimately citizen-to-citizen relations. That is at the heart of these relationships.

"Floor Amendment 3 encourages continued efforts to work for peace and to promote international goodwill through sisterstate and sister-city relations as a way to counter the national Russian government's current war policies in Ukraine. I ask for your support for this amendment."

The motion to adopt Floor Amendment No. 3 was put by the Chair and carried.
