

THIRTY-SIXTH DAY

Wednesday, March 23, 2022

The Senate of the Thirty-First Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2022, convened at 11:48 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Thirty-Fifth Day.

At this time, Senator Chang introduced two of his staff members. Seated in the gallery were office manager Lynn Robinson-Onderko and intern Kavisara Maneepun, who was visiting from Bangkok, Thailand. Senator Chang noted that Ms. Maneepun was a graduate of one of Thailand's top universities, had recently passed her law license exam, had most recently worked for international law firm Baker McKenzie, and was currently doing invaluable research on housing and other issues, which was made possible by the new age of remote work.

Senator Inouye welcomed Hawai'i County Mayor Mitch Roth, a former prosecutor, who was present in the gallery. Senator Inouye commented that Mayor Roth was working hard on many issues before the county, and that she and her colleagues were happy he was walking the floor, doing his job.

Senator San Buenaventura introduced Mayor Roth's executive assistant, Jane Clement, who was seated in the gallery, and expressed that it was an honor and a privilege that Mayor Roth and Ms. Clement had honored the Senate chamber with their presence.

Senator Wakai introduced contemporaries from the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, also known as Saipan. Present in the gallery were Donald Manglona, chair of the Ways & Means committee, and Celina Babauta, chair of the Judiciary & Governmental Operations committee.

Senator Dela Cruz moved that Stand. Com. Rep. No. 3327 be received and placed on file, seconded by Senator Keith-Agaran and carried.

Senator Dela Cruz then moved that the Senate advise and consent to the nomination of DARRYL KOMO to the Taxation Board of Review, term to expire June 30, 2025, seconded by Senator Keith-Agaran.

The motion was put by the Chair and carried on the following showing of Ayes and Noes:

Ayes, 25. Noes, none.

At this time, Senator Kim reminded members of the Committee on Higher Education of their decision-making meeting that afternoon at 12:00 noon in Room 211.

The Chair made the following announcement:
