

## FIFTY-FIFTH DAY

## Monday, April 25, 2022

The Senate of the Thirty-First Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2022, convened at 12:01 p.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present, with the exception of Senators Keohokalole and Kidani who were excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Fifty-Fourth Day.

At this time, Senator Misalucha introduced Mary Rivera, who had made history as Disney's first Filipino-speaking character in a feature film when she played the role of Ned's lola, or grandmother, in *Spider-Man: No Way Home*. Joining Ms. Rivera in the gallery were her husband, Alex; daughter Angela Kelly; Emme Tomimbang, iconic television personality of EMME, Inc., and her sister, Cori Comeau; Vicky Ramil; Stu Glauberman; Melga Gendrano; Gabriella Abbey; Sarah Luz Hosaka; Jimmy Hosaka; Dr. Efland; Yolanda Amerson; Rose Mendoza; Bing Joaquin; Mila Medallon-Kaahanui; Angie Santiago; and Bernadette and Cesar Fajardo.

The Chair extended congratulations.

On behalf of Senate President Kouchi, Senator Inouye congratulated kumu hula Leina'ala Pavao Jardin and halau Ka Lei Mokihana o Leina'ala for being the overall winner of the recent Merrie Monarch Festival.

The Chair explained that Ms. Jardin was not present in the gallery, and commented, in good humor, that he had wanted somebody to brag for Kaua'i and himself. The Chair noted that this was the first victory for a Kaua'i halau in the history of the Merrie Monarch Festival.

Senator Dela Cruz welcomed Sandy Ma from Common Cause Hawaii, noting that she was always looking out for the members and at the members, and making sure that they were all being transparent.
