Thursday, April 20, 2023

The Senate of the Thirty-Second Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2023, convened at 11:35 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present, with the exception of Senators Ihara and Shimabukuro who were excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Fifty-Second Day.
