

## SIXTH DAY

Friday, January 26, 2024

The Senate of the Thirty-Second Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2024, convened at 11:31 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present, with the exception of Senators Ihara and Lee who were excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Fifth Day.

At this time, Senator Shimabukuro introduced guests from the Nānākuli-Wai'anae school complex Papahana 'o Kaiona alternative learning program. Seated in the gallery were students Brianna Joshua, Akena Talley, Kailee Barrett, Precious Vilmaire-Keola-Noble, Prince-Toa Adkins-Talamoa, Tuputele Ofoia, Orty Chuweinuk, Kyngzten Samson-Wright, Jeremy Gonzalves-Yap, Wayne Johnson-Fontes, Charlesten Carson-Lyman, Blaze Nakapaahu, Blaydin Reyes, Trista Tiave, and Jason Miller; and kumu Danyel Panui, Shannon Bucasas, Ryan Oshita, Nicole Mikes, Kris Ginoza, and Lisa Yahiku-Hiromoto.

Senator Hashimoto acknowledged Sterling Higa from Housing Hawai'i's Future. Senator Hashimoto noted that Mr. Higa, who was visiting from Maui, was an advocate for housing. Senator Hashimoto explained that Housing Hawai'i's Future was a movement led by young people who sought to create opportunities for Hawai'i's next generation by ending the workforce housing shortage. Accompanying Mr. Higa in the gallery was Melissa Pavlicek.

Senator Elefante welcomed Taylor Sayles, his session staff member, who was present in the gallery.

Senator Dela Cruz introduced Ceylinsena Erol, an exchange student from Turkey attending Mililani High School, who was seated in the gallery. Senator Dela Cruz noted that Ms. Erol hoped to pursue dentistry and international relations, volunteered with AccesSurf, and had participated in flag football and was on the judo team at Mililani High School. Senator Dela Cruz then acknowledged two students from JEI University in Incheon who were present in the gallery.

Senator Wakai welcomed Kotryna Kalinina, an exchange student from Lithuania attending Parker School in Waimea, Hawai'i, who was seated in the gallery. Senator Wakai stated that Ms. Kalinina enjoyed paddling and tennis, aspired to be a dermatologist, and wished to apply to the University of Hawai'i's nursing program or medical program.

Senator Aquino introduced members of his staff who were present in the gallery: office manager Maureen Andrade; committee clerk Jayne Nantkes; and Nathaniel Isei, who had offered a moment of contemplation prior to the Senate's floor session.
