

EIGHTEENTH DAY

Tuesday, February 13, 2024

The Senate of the Thirty-Second Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2024, convened at 11:48 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present, with the exception of Senators Hashimoto and Ihara who were excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Seventeenth Day.

At this time, Senator Kim acknowledged Kamehameha Schools Kapālama Middle School students who were at the Capitol to learn about leadership and community service. Joining them in the gallery were kumu Ray Parker, Ryan Parker, and Ka'imi Valladares. Senator Kim then requested that the names of the students be entered into the Journal, and the Chair so ordered.

Senators Keohokalole and Chang, for the Committee on Commerce and Consumer Protection and the Committee on Housing, presented a joint report (Stand. Com. Rep. No. 2303) recommending that S.B. No. 2026, as amended in S.D. 1, pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

On motion by Senator Wakai, seconded by Senator DeCoite and carried, the joint report of the Committees was adopted and S.B. No. 2026, S.D. 1, entitled: "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO DEPOSITS OF PUBLIC FUNDS," passed Second Reading and was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Senators Wakai and San Buenaventura, for the Committee on Public Safety and Intergovernmental and Military Affairs and the Committee on Health and Human Services, presented a joint report (Stand. Com. Rep. No. 2304) recommending that S.B. No. 2305, as amended in S.D. 1, pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

On motion by Senator Wakai, seconded by Senator DeCoite and carried, the joint report of the Committees was adopted and S.B. No. 2305, S.D. 1, entitled: "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO MISSING PERSONS," passed Second Reading and was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Senators Inouye and Wakai, for the Committee on Water and Land and the Committee on Public Safety and Intergovernmental and Military Affairs, presented a joint report (Stand. Com. Rep. No. 2305) recommending that S.B. No. 2162, as amended in S.D. 1, pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

On motion by Senator Wakai, seconded by Senator DeCoite and carried, the joint report of the Committees was adopted and S.B. No. 2162, S.D. 1, entitled: "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE CONSERVATION AND RESOURCES ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM," passed Second Reading and was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
