

## NINETEENTH DAY

## Thursday, February 13, 2025

The Senate of the Thirty-Third Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2025, convened at 11:31 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present, with the exception of Senator Ihara who was excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Eighteenth Day.

At this time, Senator DeCoite introduced students and their chaperones from Seabury Hall on Maui who were visiting the Capitol: students Isaac (Kalani) Adolpho, Reagan Aguas, Olivia Aoki, Kailia Carver, Makani Deponte, Jacob Robello, and Wyatt (Kaua) Wong Leong and advisors Sydney Diedrich and Chris Golding.

Senator Keohokalole welcomed Jace Mikulanec, a representative of Queen's Health Systems who worked on local healthcare issues; and Stanford Carr, a leader in affordable housing development, who were seated in the gallery.
