

TWENTY-SIXTH DAY

Thursday, March 6, 2025

The Senate of the Thirty-Third Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2025, convened at 11:35 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present, with the exception of Senator Lee who was excused.

The President announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Twenty-Fifth Day.

At this time, Senator Rhoads introduced a constituent, Lieutenant Governor Sylvia Luke, who was seated in the gallery.

Senator Moriwaki welcomed Rajan Zed, a guest from Nevada and president of the Universal Society of Hinduism who had offered a moment of contemplation prior to the Senate's floor session. Senator Moriwaki noted that Mr. Zed travelled nationally and internationally to promote peace and interfaith dialogue with leaders of diverse religions and nonbelievers. Accompanying him in the gallery were members of Senator Moriwaki's staff: office manager Venus Delos Santos, Alexander Ozawa, Charles Izumoto, Cody Rex, and CIP staff member Joe Kopschy.

Senator DeCoite recognized volunteer intern La'i Reyes, who was originally from Moloka'i and was attending St. Andrew's Priory in Honolulu, who was present in the gallery. Senator DeCoite also acknowledged staff members of Lieutenant Governor Luke who were seated in the gallery who had been instrumental in working with her on a number of bills, including Michele Kurihara, Annie Aki, and Kaleo Chang.
