Friday, January 17, 2025

The Senate of the Thirty-Third Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2025, convened at 11:35 a.m. with the Vice President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present, with the exception of Senator Kouchi who was excused.

The Chair announced that she had read and approved the Journal of the Second Day.

At this time, Senator Kanuha noted that the Senate had joined with the Chamber of Commerce Hawaii that month in celebrating the chamber's annual Chamber Week. Senator Kanuha explained that each January, the Chamber of Commerce Hawaii brought together business leaders, entrepreneurs, local small-business owners, and students to engage in the legislative process. Senator Kanuha then recognized members of the chamber team who were seated in the gallery and requested that the names of all chamber teams and students in the gallery be entered into the Journal, and the Chair so ordered. Senator Kanuha noted that Department of Education high-school students were in attendance with the Chamber of Commerce Hawaii, applying their research and practicing advocacy, and had earlier that morning proposed solutions to address challenges in their communities. Senator Kanuha announced that the students would be visiting offices that afternoon during their Capitol walkaround.

Senator Fevella welcomed 50 students from Campbell High School who had earlier that morning shared a presentation focused on bike and pedestrian safety who were present in the gallery.

Senator Aquino acknowledged 40 students from Waipahu High School who had advocated for the redevelopment of Waipahu District Park who were seated in the gallery.
