

EIGHTEENTH DAY

Wednesday, February 12, 2025

The Senate of the Thirty-Third Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2025, convened at 11:36 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present.

The Chair announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Seventeenth Day.

At this time, Senator Inouye introduced members of her staff who were seated in the gallery: office manager Tammie Kotani, committee clerk Monique Tokumi, and longtime friend and session hire Mel Ah Ching.

Senator Wakai noted that students from Okinawa had been coming to Hawai'i for 35 years in the state's longest-running high school student exchange program. Senator Wakai then recognized the following visitors: students from Okinawa; Hajime Miyagi, Naoki Oshiro, English teacher Tomiaki Yamada, and English teacher Shiori Shimabukuro, Board of Education officials from Okinawa; and, representing the Hawaii United Okinawa Association, David Arakawa from community relations and executive director Jon Itomura. Senator Wakai requested that the names of the Okinawan students be entered into the Journal, and the Chair so ordered.

Senator Awa recognized and congratulated Kailua's Tuli Gabbard, who had been confirmed as director of national intelligence by the U.S. Senate.
