Pursuant to Section 16 of Article III of the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i, I am returning herewith, without my approval, House Bill No. 300, entitled "A Bill for an Act Relating to the State Budget."

The purpose of this bill, the General Appropriations Act of 2025, is to appropriate funds for the fiscal biennium 2025-2027 to fund the operations and capital improvement projects of the Executive Branch agencies and programs.

While the bill as a whole has merit, the use of general fund moneys must be reprioritized due to: (1) the change in the Council on Revenues' general fund tax revenue projection in May 2025, which necessitates that the State's financial plan be rebalanced through line-item vetoes and reductions to the budget, and (2) the need to maintain flexibility to plan for the possibility of federal government cutbacks.

Because of the need to reprioritize the use of general fund moneys, the general fund appropriations were subject to: (1) an assessment of new programs or programs in which future recurring funds would be needed that were not currently budgeted, (2) an evaluation of each expending agency's ability and capacity to spend down the moneys efficiently within the authorized appropriation period, (3) an assessment of the availability of other funds that could support program or project goals, and (4) a determination of whether such an appropriation could be revisited at a later date, when more information about the federal funding changes is available.

Section 16 of Article III of the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i provides that, "[e]xcept for items appropriated to be expended by the judicial and legislative branches, the governor may veto any specific item or items in any bill which appropriates money for specific purposes by striking out or reducing the same." Consequently, I object to the expenditure of some of the appropriations in this bill, for the reasons indicated.

Of the general fund program appropriations set forth in section 3 of this bill, I object to the following items because of the lower revenues projected by the Council on Revenues and the need to maintain flexibility to plan for the possibility of federal government cutbacks.

Specific Items Vetoed

Because of the foregoing objections, I have taken the following actions on specific appropriation items set forth in section 3 at the stated page and line numbers of this bill,

pursuant to my appropriation line-item veto authority, as follows:

1. For item A-24, BED 143 - Hawaii Technology Development Corporation, on page 9, line 15, reduced by \$2,000,000 of the total \$4,701,795 appropriation for fiscal year 2026-2027 funded by general funds, and changed it to \$2,701,795.

2. For item E-15, HTH430 - Adult Mental Health - Inpatient, on page 24, line 25, reduced by \$10,000,000 of the total \$157,045,865 appropriation for fiscal year 2025-2026 funded by general funds, and changed it to \$147,045,865.

3. For item G-5, EDN400 - School Support, on page 33, line 4, reduced by \$45,000,000 of the total \$425,299,069 appropriation for fiscal year 2025-2026 funded by general funds, and changed it to \$380,299,069, and reduced by \$45,000,000 of the total \$423,937,360 appropriation for fiscal year 2026-2027 funded by general funds, and changed it to \$378,937,360.

4. For item G-17, UOH100 - University of Hawaii, Manoa, on page 34, line 38, reduced by \$785,000 of the total \$290,419,091 appropriation for fiscal year 2025-2026 funded by general funds, and changed it to \$289,634,091.

5. For item I-16, LAW504 - Criminal Investigation Division, on page 40, line 30, reduced by \$500,000 of the total \$4,113,508 appropriation for fiscal year 2025-2026 funded by general funds, and changed it to \$3,613,508.

6. For item I-18, LAW900 - General Administration, on page 40, line 41, reduced by \$3,000,000 of the total \$20,894,244 appropriation for fiscal year 2025-2026 funded by general funds, and changed it to \$17,894,244.

Pursuant to Section 16 of Article III of the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i, I am returning herewith, without my approval, House Bill No. 235, entitled "A Bill for an Act Relating to Traffic Safety."

The purpose of this bill is to improve traffic and pedestrian safety along the North Shore of Oahu. To achieve this, the bill requires the Department of Transportation to expand the use of photo red light imaging detector systems and automated speed enforcement systems to locations on the North Shore, following public education efforts by the City and County of Honolulu about the traffic enforcement systems.

This bill is objectionable because by selecting unidentified locations on the North Shore of Oahu for expansion of the use of photo red light imaging detector systems and automated speed enforcement systems, the bill ignores that the Department of Transportation (DOT) has established a statewide methodology for selecting the communities and expansion areas within which to implement these types of traffic safety systems. The criteria in the DOT's methodology include the number of crashes caused by drivers who disregarded traffic signals, volume of traffic, and traffic citations for disregarding signals. The DOT stresses the importance of consistency when selecting a location for implementation of the traffic safety systems.

DOT's methodology ensures communities are chosen based on need and potential for greatest impact. Disregarding the DOT's criteria for location selection threatens the integrity of the photo red light imaging detector system and automated speed enforcement system programs.

For the foregoing reasons, I am returning House Bill No. 235 without my approval.

This bill is objectionable because it would have a deleterious long-term impact on income tax credits across a variety of important industries, including film and television, research, and renewable energy. These tax credits are critical to supporting economic development and diversification, particularly within growing and emerging sectors. Categorically sunseting income tax credits will not only disincentivize future investors from doing business in Hawai'i but will also destabilize existing businesses that currently rely upon these tax credits.

Pursuant to Section 16 of Article III of the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i, I am returning herewith, without my approval, House Bill No. 958, entitled "A Bill for an Act Relating to Transportation."

The purposes of this bill are to provide additional clarity to existing law and reinforce statewide education efforts to promote safe and responsible electrical bicycle use. Among other things, the bill prohibits operating a "high-speed electric device" on a public roadway and other designated areas.

This bill is objectionable because the definition of "high-speed electric device" and the prohibition of such devices on public roadways may be construed to include electric motor vehicles.

The bill defines "high-speed electric device" as "any device with a motor exceeding seven hundred fifty watts and capable of speeds over twenty-eight miles per hour." There are exceptions for mopeds and motorcycles, but not for electric motor vehicles, which otherwise fall within this definition. An earlier version of the bill limited the definition to two-wheeled electric devices, but the definition was subsequently amended from "a two-wheeled electric device" to "any device," without adding electric motor vehicles to the exclusions provided for mopeds and motorcycles.

Moreover, there is no definition of "device" in the current law that would preclude electric motor vehicles from being subject to the requirements of this bill. Instead, "vehicles" under section 291C-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), are broadly defined as "devices" for transporting people and property. Consequently, under the plain language of this bill and chapter 291C, HRS, an electric motor vehicle would be considered a "high-speed electric device" and therefore prohibited from being operated on public roadways if this bill were to become law.

While it appears that the failure to exempt electric motor vehicles from the prohibition in the bill was inadvertent, it would nevertheless cause confusion about the legality of using electric motor vehicles on the State's public roadways and conflict with my commitment to reducing greenhouse gases.

For the foregoing reasons, I am returning House Bill No. 958 without my approval.

This bill is objectionable because it will interfere with the ability of the Administration to quickly deploy resources in the Fund in response to emergencies. During emergencies, it is critical that the Administration have flexibility to address rapidly changing situations. The Administration is committed to using state funds in a transparent and efficient manner. However, the new administrative burdens this bill places on utilizing the Fund may jeopardize public safety.

Unfortunately, the bill does not provide a mechanism to prevent the recording of frivolous or false statements or notices, nor does it provide a remedy for property owners who might be affected by the recording of frivolous or false statements or notices.

This bill is objectionable because the exceptions from chapter 102, which regulates bidding for concessions contracts, may likely be determined by a court to violate the single subject requirement of section 14 of article III of the State Constitution, which provides, in part: "Each law shall embrace but one subject, which shall be expressed in its title." The one subject expressed in this bill's title is "naming rights." Accordingly, the inclusion of exemptions relating to concessions contracts from chapter 102, HRS, in this bill expose it to constitutional challenge.
