

TWENTY-SIXTH DAY

Thursday, March 12, 2026

The Senate of the Thirty-Third Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2026, convened at 11:34 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Roll was called showing all Senators present, with the exception of Senator Fevella who was excused.

The Chair announced that he had read and approved the Journal of the Twenty-Fifth Day.

At this time, Senator Rhoads observed that more than 2,600 YMCAs served nearly 17 million youth and adults each year in 10,000 communities across all 50 states and that that year, the YMCA would celebrate 175 years of strengthening communities and changing lives. Senator Rhoads added that the governor had proclaimed that day to be YMCA Day in Hawai'i. Senator Rhoads noted that the YMCA was a charitable nonprofit that provided child care for working families, programs that supported the physical and mental health of kūpuna and adults, water safety and youth development for keiki, and opportunities for volunteers and young leaders to grow and give back. Senator Rhoads then recognized YMCA staff, students, and volunteers representing the islands of Hawai'i and O'ahu who were present in the gallery, including Wendy Botelho, CEO of Island of Hawai'i YMCA; and Walter Thoemmes, CEO of the YMCA of Honolulu.

The Chair shared that, when he had attended Drake University in Des Moines, Iowa, he had spent two years of his work-study program working for the Des Moines YMCA, which had helped him attain his education. The Chair expressed appreciation for all that the YMCA does.

Senator San Buenaventura noted Ms. Botelho had come to the Capitol despite having had to go to the emergency room recently from breathing in Pele's hair from tephra, which showed her commitment to the YMCA. Senator San Buenaventura then welcomed Martha Rodillas, who was present in the gallery. Senator San Buenaventura also introduced members of her staff who were seated in the gallery: Monique Tokumi and Kamana Levy.

Senator Elefante recognized Jay Franzone from Everytown for Gun Safety, who was present in the gallery.

Senator McKelvey introduced members of his staff who were seated in the gallery: Wendee Wilson and Beth Kalama.

Senator San Buenaventura acknowledged her longtime office clerk, John Honda, who was present in the gallery.
