At this time, Senator San Buenaventura reminded the members about the Dress for Success clothing drive and requested that members bring in women’s business attire, especially plus-size clothing and shoes sized 10.5 and up. Senator San Buenaventura explained the process for dropping off donations at her office in Room 213 or Representative Gregg Takayama’s office in Room 404 from April 13th to April 17th.

Senator San Buenaventura then announced that April 14th would be Massage Day at the Capitol from 9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on the Rotunda.

Senator DeCoite announced that Tourism Day at the Capitol, hosted by the Hawaii Tourism Authority in partnership with the American Hotel and Lodging Association, was still scheduled for the following day from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and would highlight the important role tourism played in the local economy and communities. Senator DeCoite noted that there would be an opening program in the Auditorium featuring entertainment by Tihati Productions followed by performances from the Hawaiian Air Troupe and Henry Kapono Foundation. Senator DeCoite added that exhibitions would be held on the fourth floor from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Senator Gabbard extended happy birthday wishes to the majority leader from District 3 on Hawai’i Island and shared that the toffee had been delivered.

Senator Lamosao explained that that day marked Araw ng Kagitingan, or Day of Valor, which was observed annually on April 9th and paid tribute to the courage and sacrifice of Filipino and American servicemen who fought side by side during World War II in defense of freedom and democracy. Senator Lamosao noted that the commemoration also marked the 80th anniversary of diplomatic relations between the U.S. and the Republic of the Philippines, a partnership rooted in shared values, mutual respect, and a commitment to peace and prosperity and that that bond was especially strong in Hawai’i, where, for over a century, the Filipino community had helped shape the islands and continued to enrich its culture and society. Senator Lamosao then invited the members to join the Filipino Caucus for a special event in Governor Green’s Ceremonial Room that afternoon from 2:00 to 2:30 p.m., where a joint House and Senate certificate would be presented to the Philippine Consulate honoring the 80th anniversary milestone.

Senator Lee stated that other members had already said what he had planned to say and added, in good humor, that AARP was having an open enrollment for all senators whose birthday was that day.

Senator Fevella requested that comments on S.R. No. 7 and S.R. No. 45 be entered into the Journal, and the Chair so ordered.

Senator Kim, following up on the announcement by the senator from Waipahu, asserted that if members ate the lumpia, they should attend the event at 2:00 p.m.

The Chair, in good humor, observed that “there [was] no free lumpia.”

Senator Dela Cruz welcomed the majority leader to the AARP club.
