SECTION 1. House Bill No. 2275, H.D. 1, S.D. 2, C.D. 1, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately inserted and to read as follows:

"SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the governor may authorize the transfer of up to \$100,000,000 in funds appropriated out of the major disaster fund pursuant to this part to other state agencies to address disaster recovery costs; provided that the governor, in a written determination, specifically finds that the reallocation or use of the moneys transferred is essential to address an imminent threat to public health, safety, or welfare arising from the emergency; provided further that the governor shall transmit a written notice of that determination, including a detailed justification, to the legislature within five days of each use of this authority, or as

soon as practicable under exigent circumstances; and provided further that the written determination shall include the date of transfer, the amount of the transfer, the program ID of the program to which the funds were transferred, and an explanation of the purpose of the transfer of resources; and provided further that any funds relating to this part that are not expended for this purpose shall lapse to the general fund on June 30, 2027.

Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the governor shall submit to the legislature, no later than thirty days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2027, a summary report containing the aforementioned information for each use of this authority for the previous twelve-month period from December 1 to November 30.

Any reallocation or use of funds pursuant to this part shall be limited in scope and duration to that which is strictly necessary to address the emergency, and shall terminate upon the ending of the emergency or upon legislative action."

SECTION 2. House Bill No. 2275, H.D. 1, S.D. 2, C.D. 1, is amended by renumbering the existing section 9 as section 10.

"If a final judgment, no longer subject to appeal, by a court of competent jurisdiction limits, invalidates, or enjoins the operation of this subsection, in whole or in part, in any respect, including as applied to any person, entity, or circumstance, or renders this subsection as having no legal effect, in whole or in part, in any respect, including as applied to any person, entity, or circumstance, as of the entry of such judgment, then the entirety of Act _____, Session Laws of Hawaii 2026, shall be deemed invalid and have no force or effect."

SECTION 3. Senate Bill No. 2471, S.D. 2, H.D. 2, C.D. 1, section 27, is amended by changing the effective date from January 1, 2027, to July 1, 2027, to read as follows:

SECTION 1. Senate Bill No. 2069, S.D. 2, H.D. 1, C.D. 1, is amended by adding a new section at page 5, line 1, to read as follows:

“SECTION 4. The Hawaii housing finance and development corporation may spend up to \$20,000,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2026-2027 from the dwelling unit revolving fund for the equity pilot program established pursuant to Act 92, Session Laws of Hawaii 2023.”

SECTION 2. Senate Bill No. 2069, S.D. 2, H.D. 1, C.D. 1, is amended by renumbering sections 4 and 5 as sections 5 and 6, respectively.

Senator San Buenaventura then offered the following floor amendment (Floor Amendment No. 12) to H.B. No. 1334, H.D. 3, S.D. 2, C.D. 1:

Section 1. House Bill No. 1334, H.D. 3, S.D. 2, C.D. 1, section 1, is amended by amending section 159- (d), Hawaii Revised Statutes, to change the word “virus” on page 3, line 3, to “disease”, and to read as follows:

“(d) The axis deer meat donation pilot program established pursuant to this section shall be operative on an island with a population over one hundred fifty thousand but less than two hundred thousand; provided that if a recognized outbreak of a known disease, as determined by the department of agriculture and biosecurity, exists in the pilot program location, the pilot program shall not continue until the outbreak is resolved, as determined by the department.”
