- **RELATING TO HIGHWAYS** TIA SB 3031 Allows use of HOV lanes by all vehicles between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. on Interstate Route H-1. Permits the use of Zipper Lanes by vehicles carrying two persons during specific hours. permits general use of the zipper lane during an accident or emergency on the H-1. (Kawamoto)
- **RELATING TO DRIVER'S LICENSES** SB 2316 Permits the use of foreign language exames by examiner of drivers. (Kawamoto)
