A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE FOURTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, for fiscal year 2003-2004, for the
4 following capital improvements in the fourth senatorial
5 district:

4 SECTION 2. The sums appropriated for the respective
5 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
6 department of accounting and general services.

7 SECTION 3. The appropriations made for capital improvement
8 projects authorized in this Act shall not lapse at the end of
9 the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is made;
10 provided that all appropriations which are unencumbered as of
11 June 30, 2006 shall lapse as of that date.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2003.
