In accordance with Section 9, Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii, I am requesting your immediate consideration and passage of Senate Bill No. 2363, which makes an emergency appropriate and authorization for \$1,600,000 from general funds to assist in the purchase and preservation of Waimea Valley, Oahu.

Because the timely passage of a Supplemental Appropriations Act amending fiscal year 2005-2006 appropriations cannot be assured, your timely passage of the measure is requested in order for the State as a consortium participant, to come up with their share of the costs for the acquisition of Waimea Valley, Oahu slated to occur on March 15, 2006.

We appreciate your prompt attention to this matter. The Department of Land and Natural Resources will be available to answer any questions you may have on this request.
