A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE ADULT MENTAL HEALTH DIVISION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. Although funds were appropriated to the
- 5 department of health for adult mental health services for the
- 6 fiscal period beginning July 1, 2005, and ending June 30, 2006,
- 7 a critical funding emergency now exists. The program will
- 8 expend all appropriated funds before the end of the current
- 9 fiscal year, and the department will be unable to meet its
- 10 obligation to provide services to certain adults with severe
- 11 mental illness. The primary reason for this financial situation
- 12 is the need to continue existing services and implement
- 13 additional services and activities to comply with the
- 14 requirements of the settlement agreement and subsequent orders
- 15 in United States v. State of Hawaii, Civil Number 91-00137 (DAE
- 16 KSC).

1 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate or authorize 2 moneys to address expenses related to the ongoing operations at 3 the Hawaii state hospital, to provide community-based services necessary to reduce the census at the Hawaii state hospital, and 4 5 to address expenses relating to those individuals who have already been placed in community-based services. 6 7 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the mental health and substance abuse special fund the sum of \$6,148,944, or so 8 9 much thereof as may be necessary, for fiscal year 2005-2006. 10 This amount is to be used to sustain ongoing operations, services, and activities for patients of the Hawaii state 11 12 hospital, to provide community-based services necessary to 13 reduce the census at the Hawaii state hospital, and to address expenses relating to those individuals who have already been 14 15 placed in community-based services. SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general 16 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4,724,703, or so 18 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2005-2006 to be 19 used to sustain ongoing operations, services, and activities for 20 patients of the Hawaii state hospital, to provide community-21 based services necessary to reduce the census at the Hawaii

state hospital, and to address expenses relating to those

- 3 SECTION 5. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the
- 4 department of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
